

Total Population by Gender









Cost per Offender







Unless otherwise stated, all data is derived from the NOTIS data warehouse, and includes all offenders under NDOC jurisdiction.

- 1. Data for FTEs (Full-Time Equivalent Positions) is from NDOC Human Resources. The number of institutions includes only those which currently house offenders; closed and shuttered facilities are excluded. ←
- 2. NDOC Capacity Analysis Report 202212-CA-82. The current count gives the in-house population. ←
- 3. Admissions and Releases data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report. This includes all admissions and releases from the current calendar year-to-date. ←
