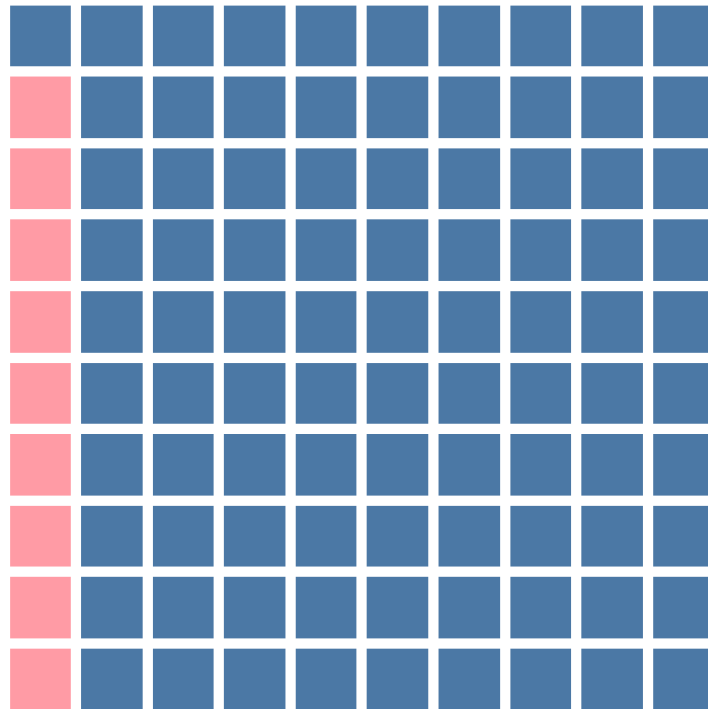

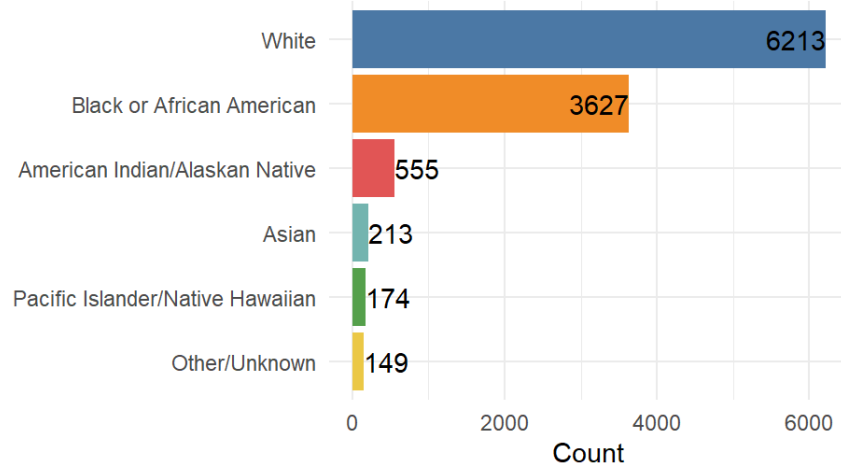

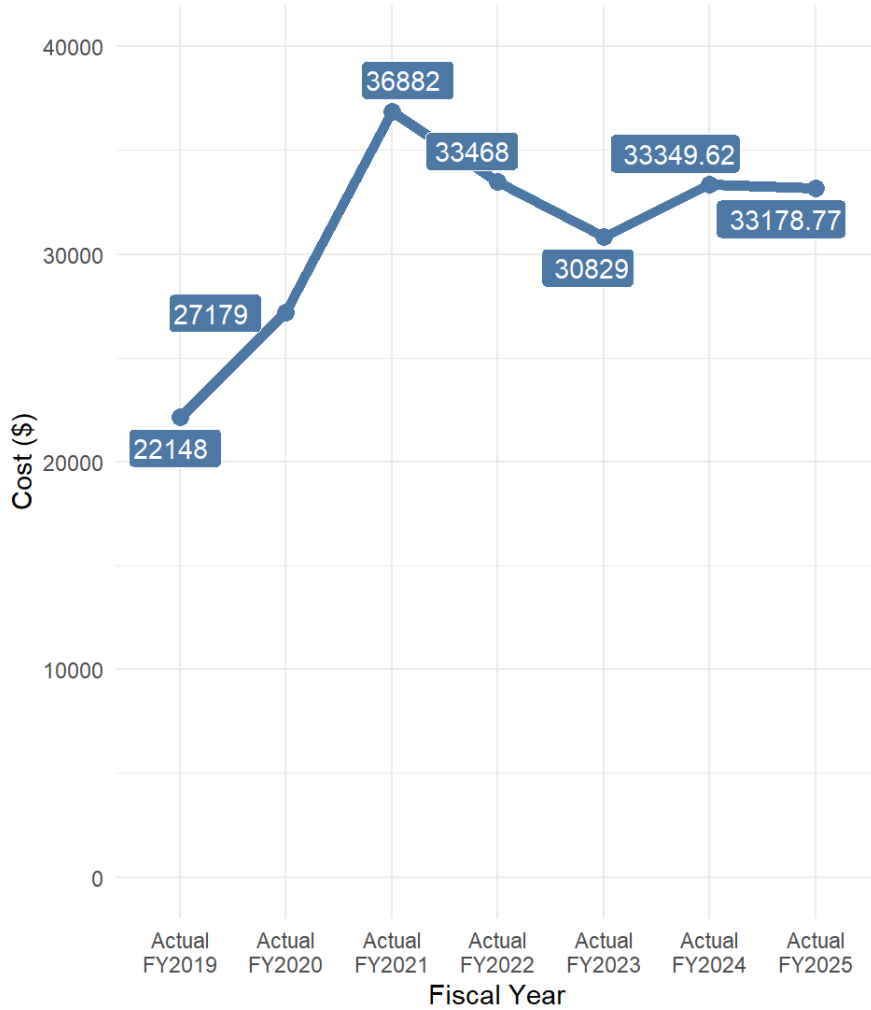

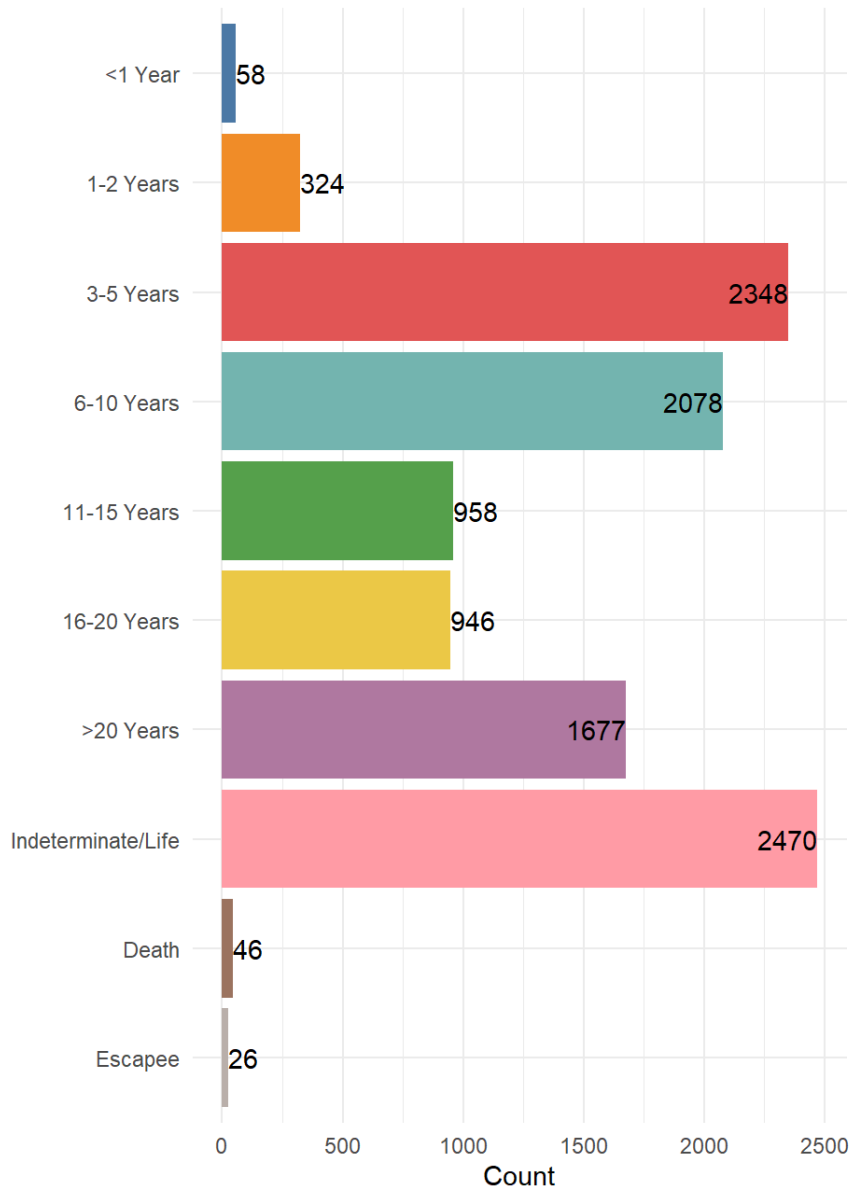

In-House Count by Approved Custody Level <sup>7</sup>

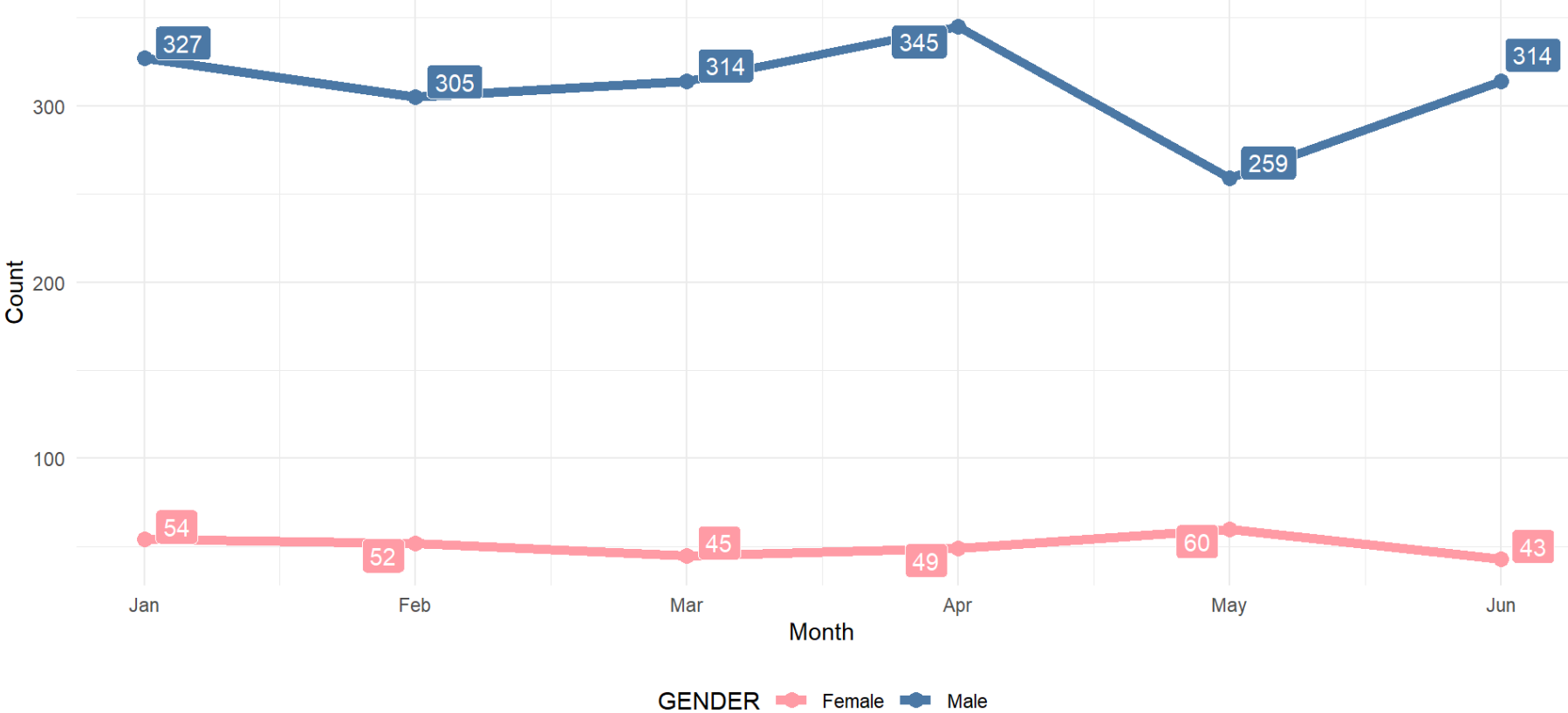

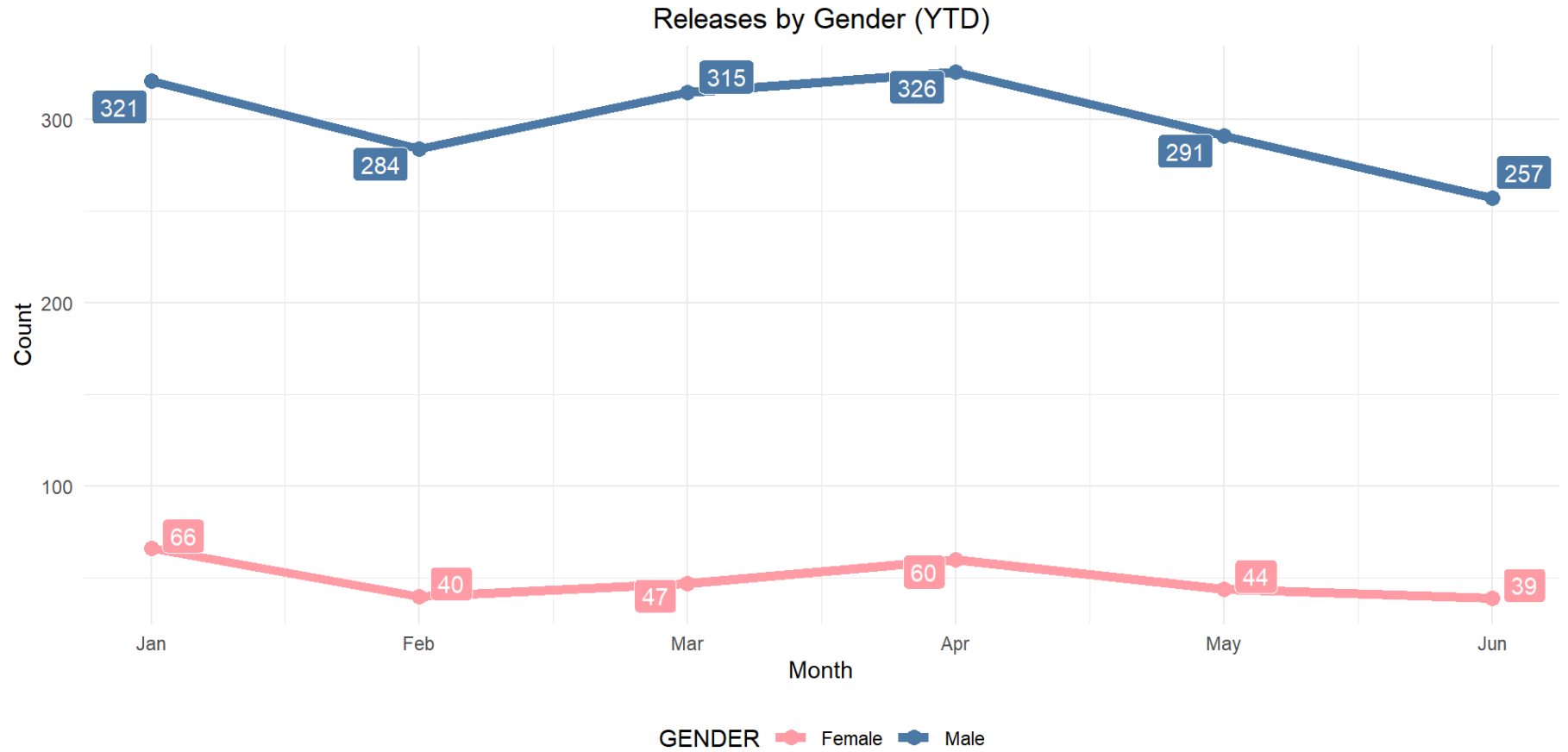
Admissions by Gender (YTD)

Releases Calendar Year-to-Date <sup>10</sup>

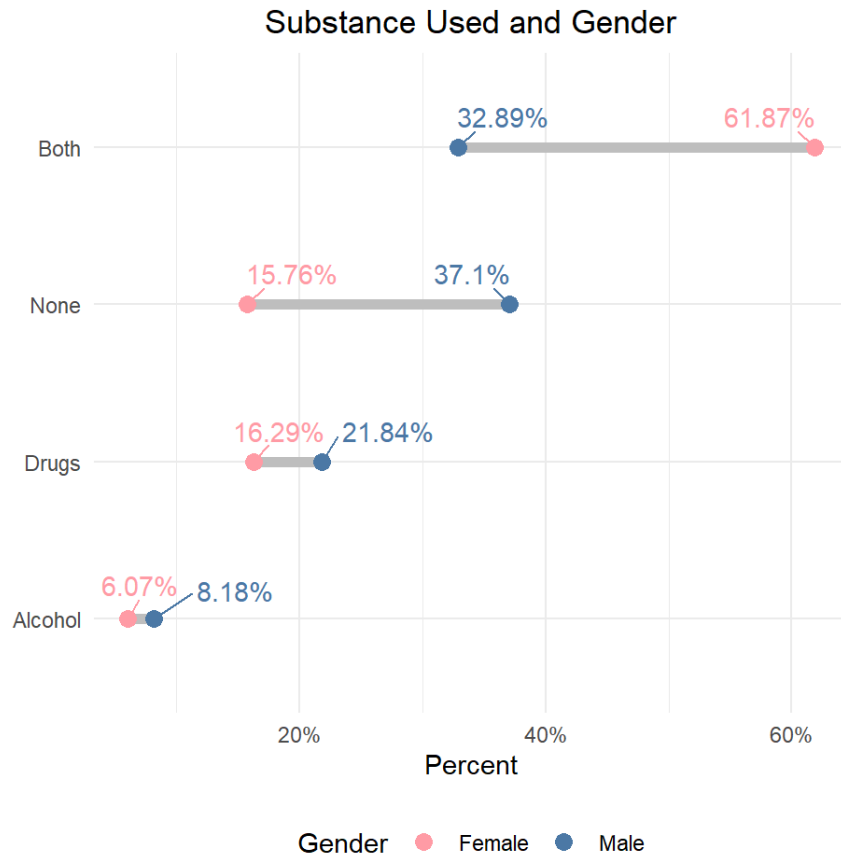

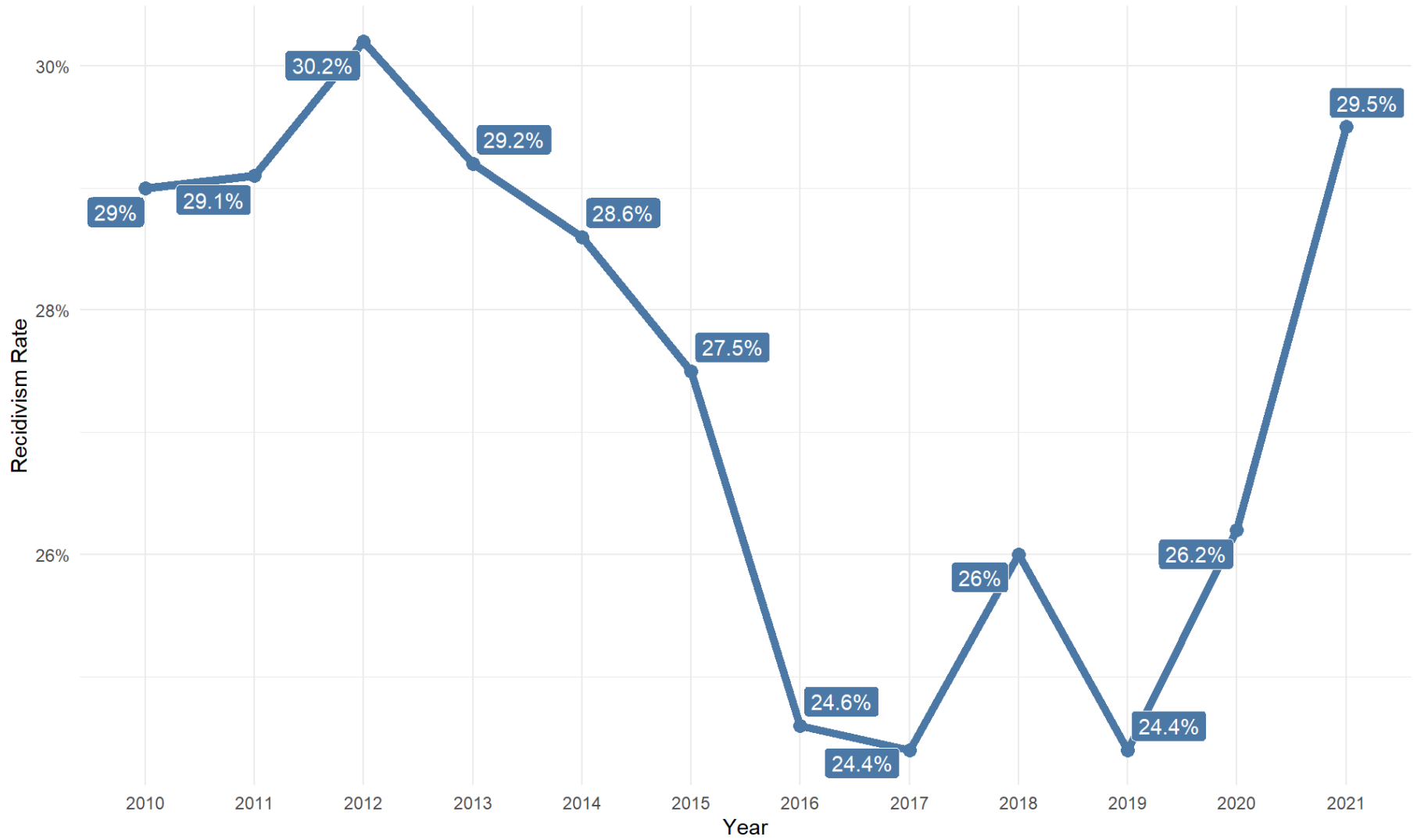

Note: The figures in this report involve estimates from live data extracted from a data warehouse. Thus, select distributions may not add up to 100% due to rounding or may not equal to the totals in published reports. Report run dates for select statistical information may affect totals and cause them not to balance to the actual population at month end until fully reconciled.

Unless otherwise stated, all data is derived from the NOTIS data warehouse, and includes all offenders under NDOC jurisdiction.

1. Data for FTEs (Full-Time Equivalent Positions) is from NDOC Human Resources. The number of institutions includes only those which currently house offenders; closed and shuttered facilities are excluded.↩
2. NDOC Capacity Analysis Report 202212-CA-82. The current count gives the in-house population.↩
3. Admissions and Releases data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report. This includes all admissions and releases from the current calendar year-to-date.↩
4. Total Population excludes offenders which are currently on parole. In-house Population only counts those who are in NDOC institutions, or are temporarily at jails or hospitals.↩
