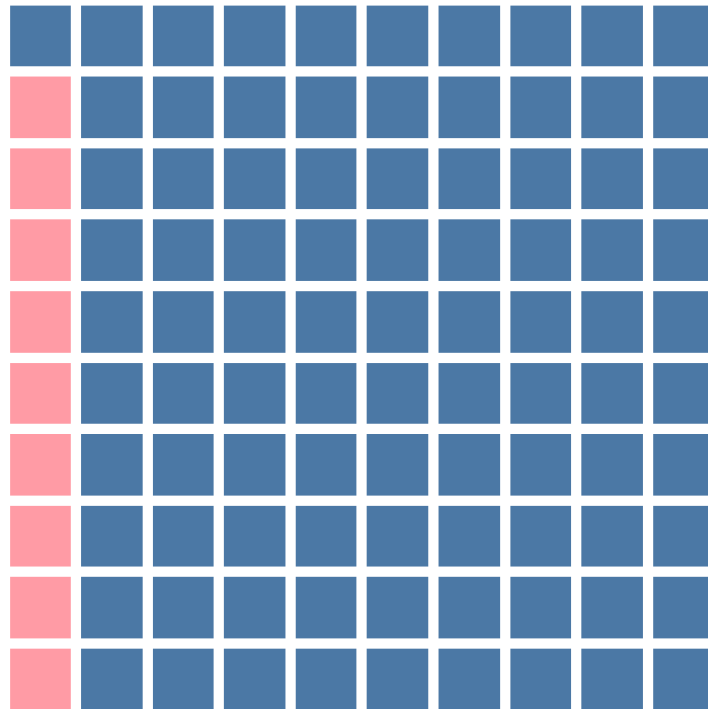

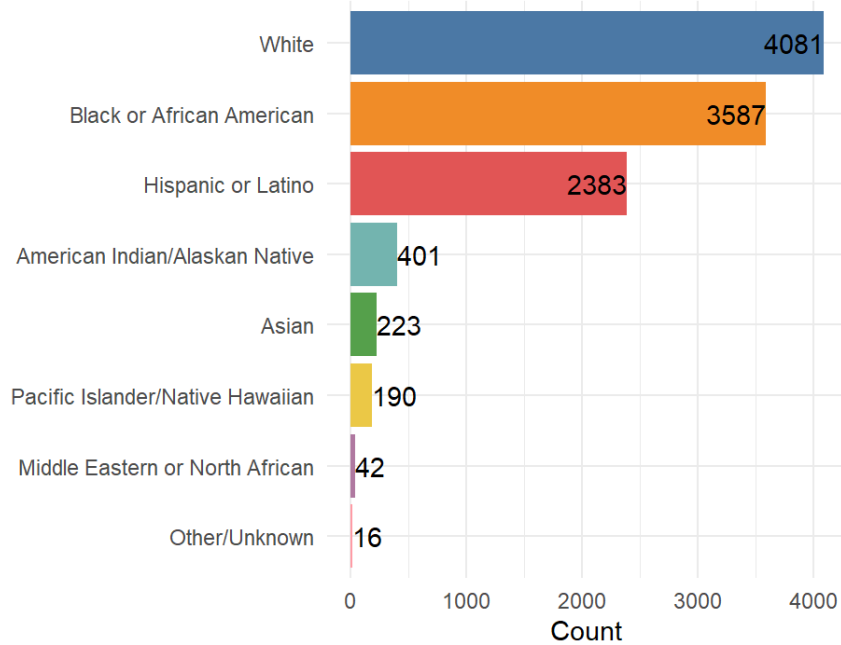

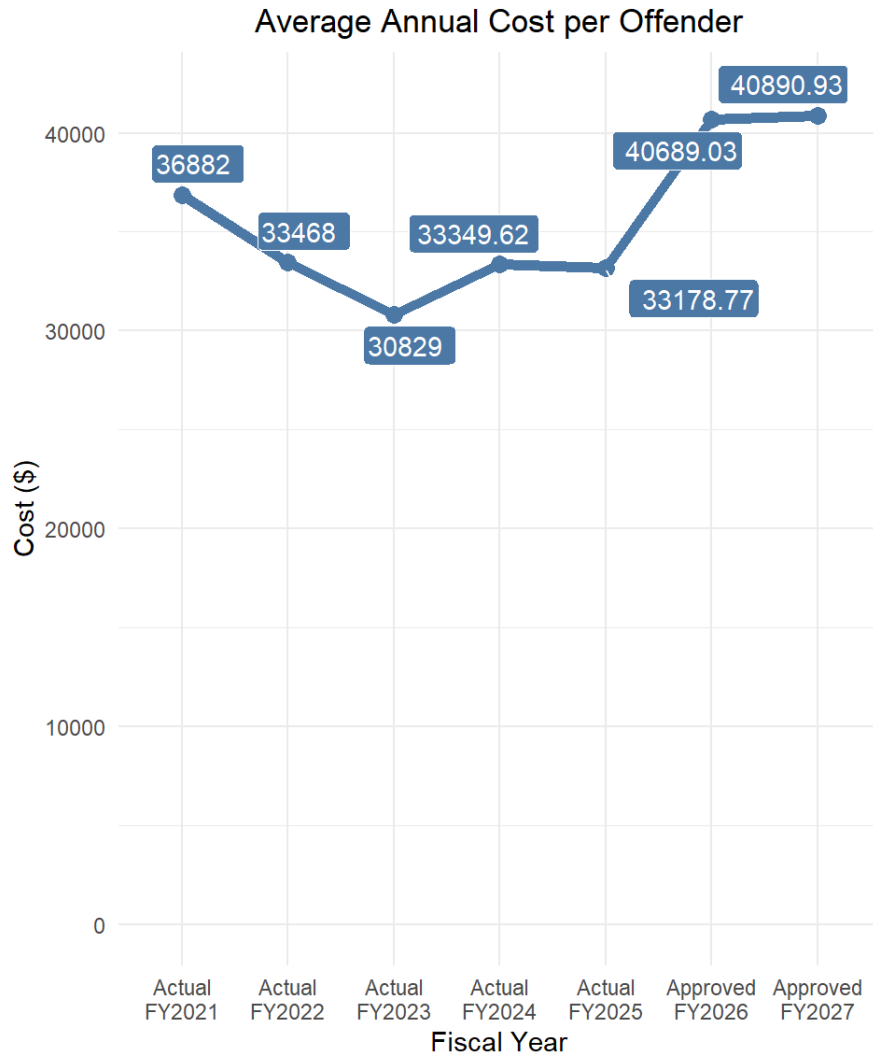

Average Annual Cost per Offender ⁵

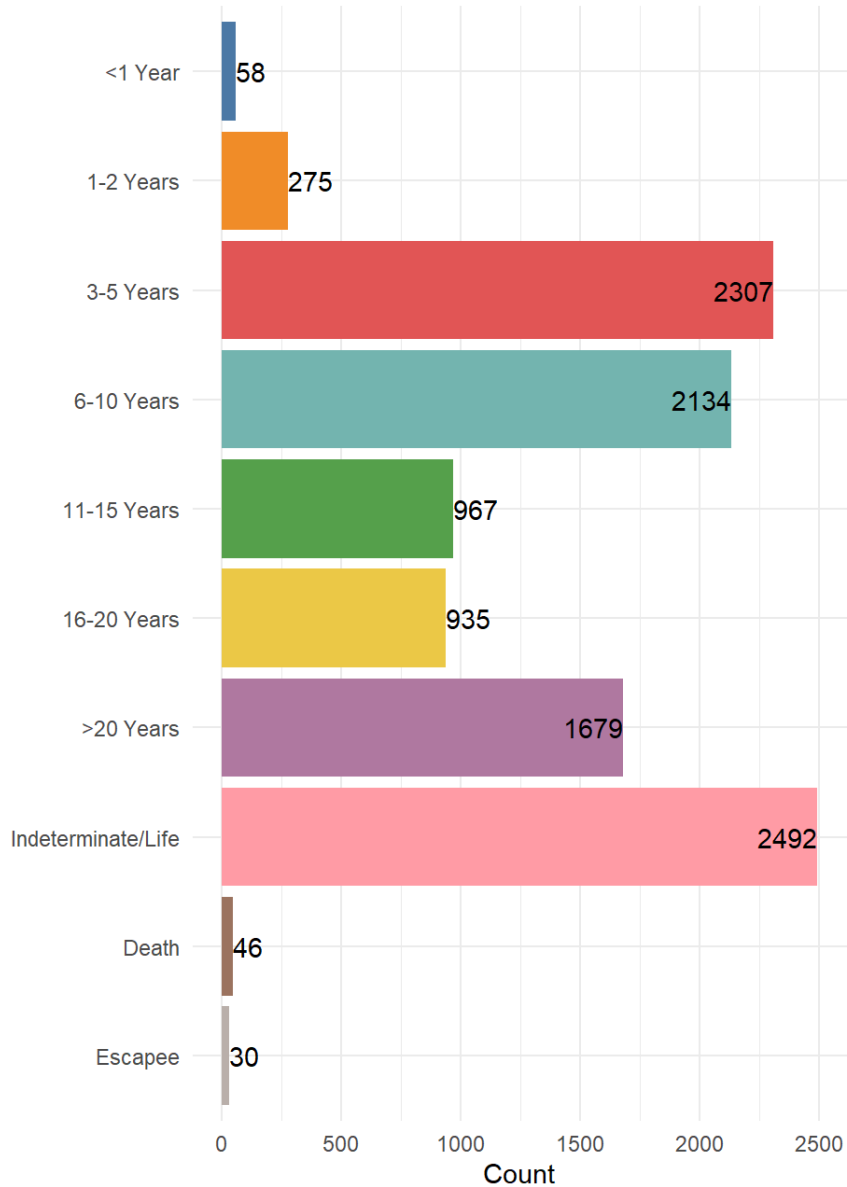

Total Population by Sentence Length



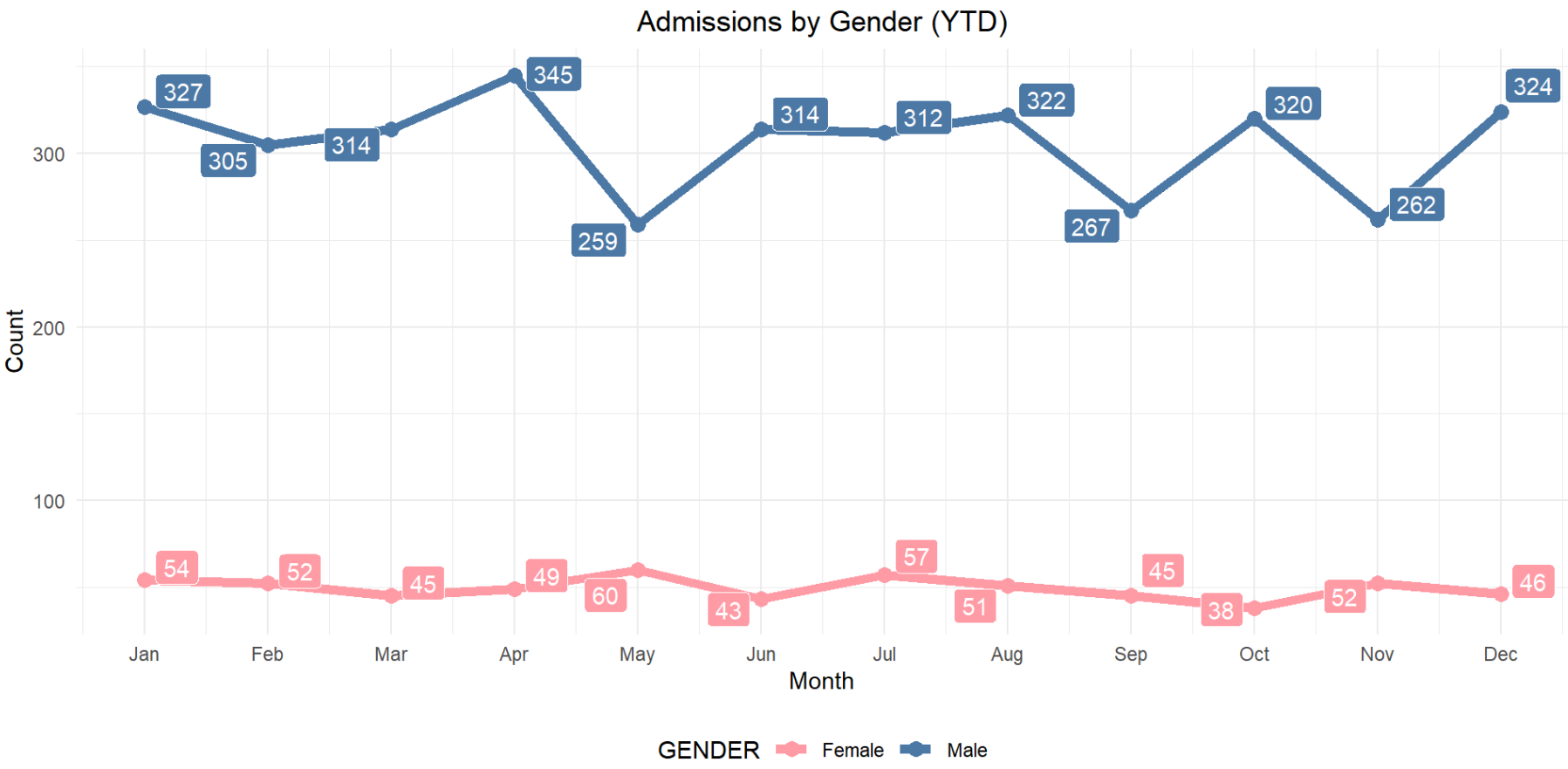

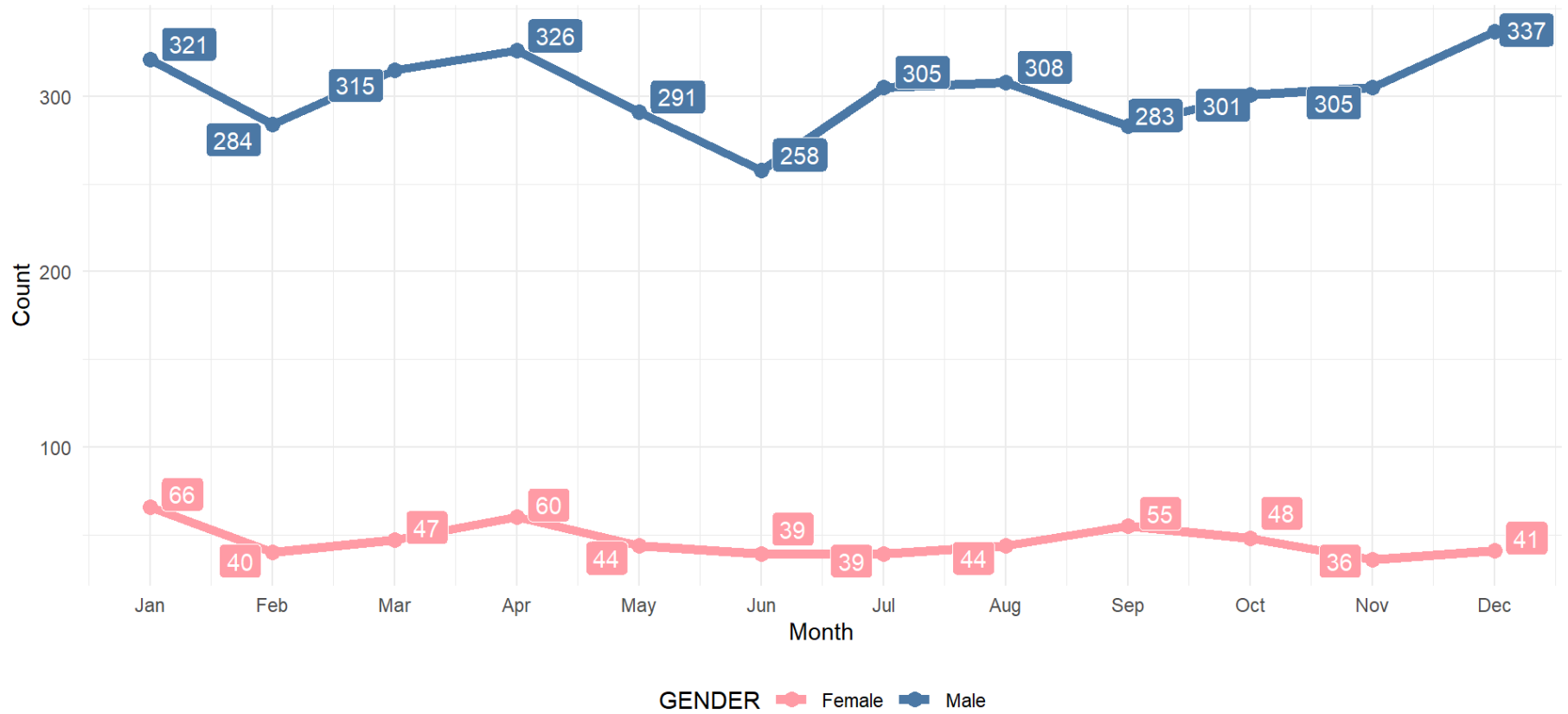


Admissions Calendar Year-to-Date ⁹

Releases Calendar Year-to-Date ¹⁰

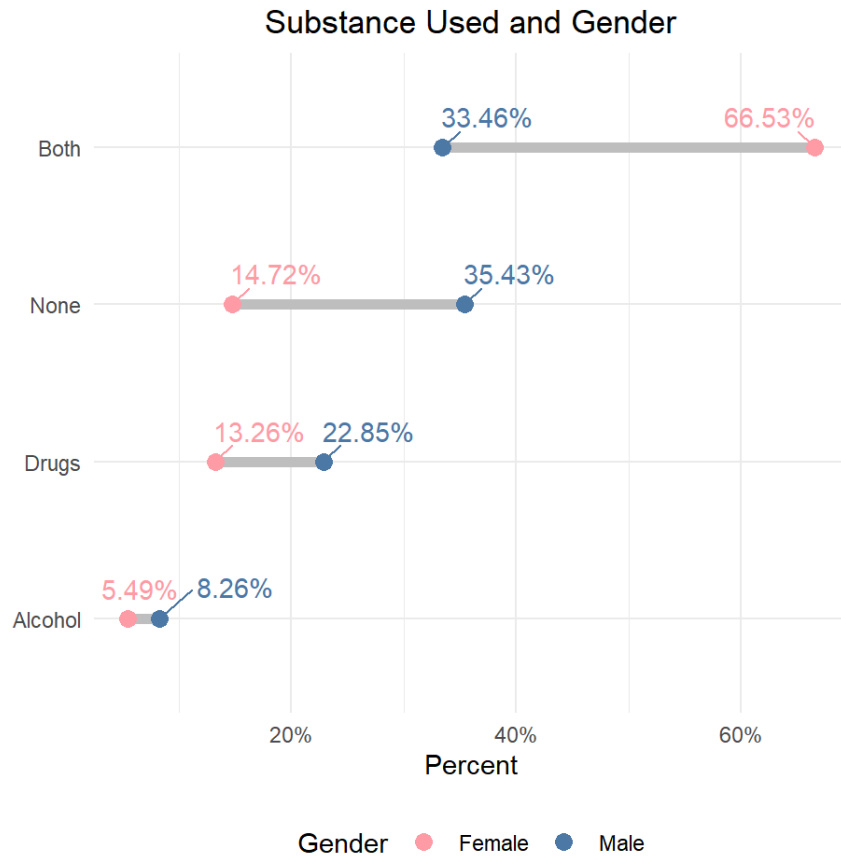

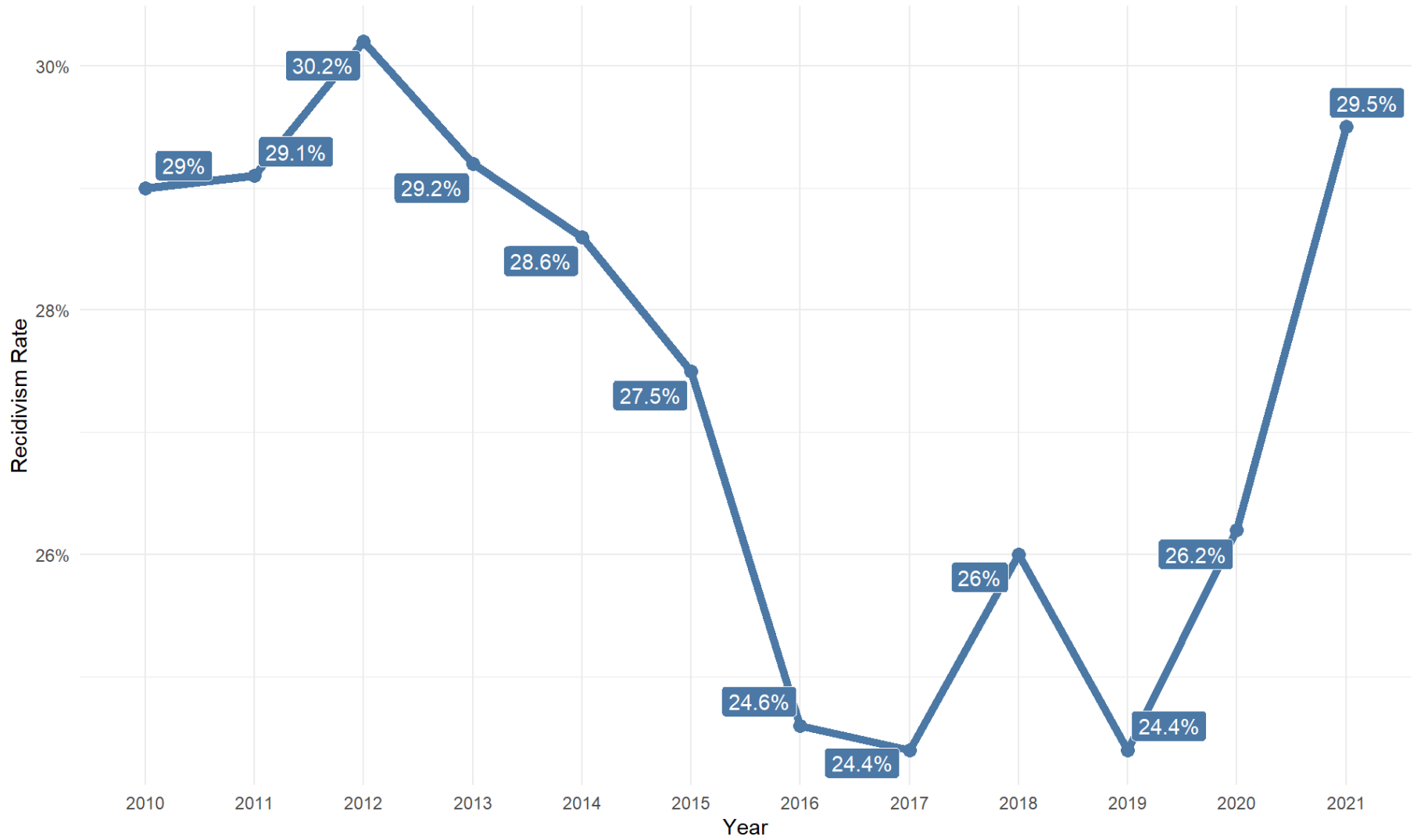

Note: The figures in this report involve estimates from live data extracted from a data warehouse. Thus, select distributions may not add up to 100% due to rounding or may not equal to the totals in published reports. Report run dates for select statistical information may affect totals and cause them not to balance to the actual population at month end until fully reconciled.

Unless otherwise stated, all data is derived from the NOTIS data warehouse, and includes all offenders under NDOC jurisdiction.

1. Data for FTEs (Full-Time Equivalent Positions) is from NDOC Human Resources. The number of institutions includes only those which currently house offenders; closed and shuttered facilities are excluded.↵
2. NDOC Capacity Analysis Report 202212-CA-82. The current count gives the in-house population.↵
3. Admissions and Releases data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report. This includes all admissions and releases from the current calendar year to date.↵
4. Total Population excludes offenders which are currently on parole. In-house Population only counts those who are in NDOC institutions, or are temporarily at jails or hospitals.↵
5. NDOC Fiscal Services, Approved Budget. The rate per correctional site is exclusive of medical, administrative, and correctional program costs.↵
6. NDOC Fiscal Services Division, Operating Cost per Inmate History.↵
7. This only includes in-house offenders.↵
8. Sentencing information is derived from the NOTIS data warehouse and gives the remaining length of time until an offender's maximum sentence has been satisfied for determinate sentences. This figure reports the total NDOC population, including escapees and those in residential or out-of-state confinement.↵
9. Admissions data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report.↵
10. Releases data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report.↵
11. This distribution is derived from data from the NOTIS data warehouse. This only includes prisoners which are currently on parole. Parole information is from Nevada Division of Parole and Probation.↵
12. Admissions and Releases data is derived from the NOTIS Web Admissions and Releases report. This includes all admissions and releases from the current calendar year to date.↵

13. The recidivism rate at NDOC represents the proportion of offenders that are re-incarcerated within three years of release. This excludes offenders who were released from non-correctional facilities, were released from other jurisdictions, or were held by NDOC for other jurisdictions. This figure is not adjusted for deaths after release.↵
14. Residential Confinement data is derived from a report maintained by the NDOC Offender Management Division Case Work Specialists.↵
