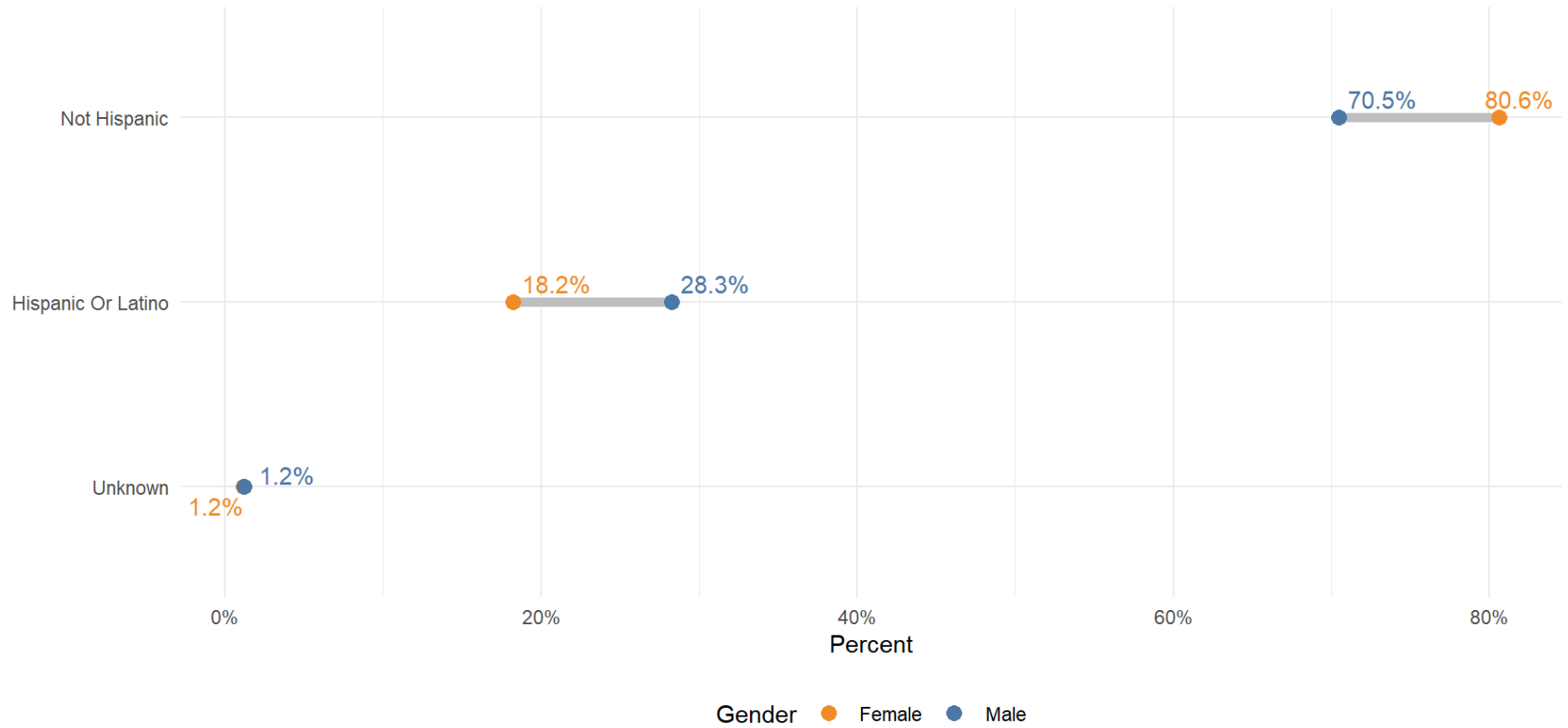

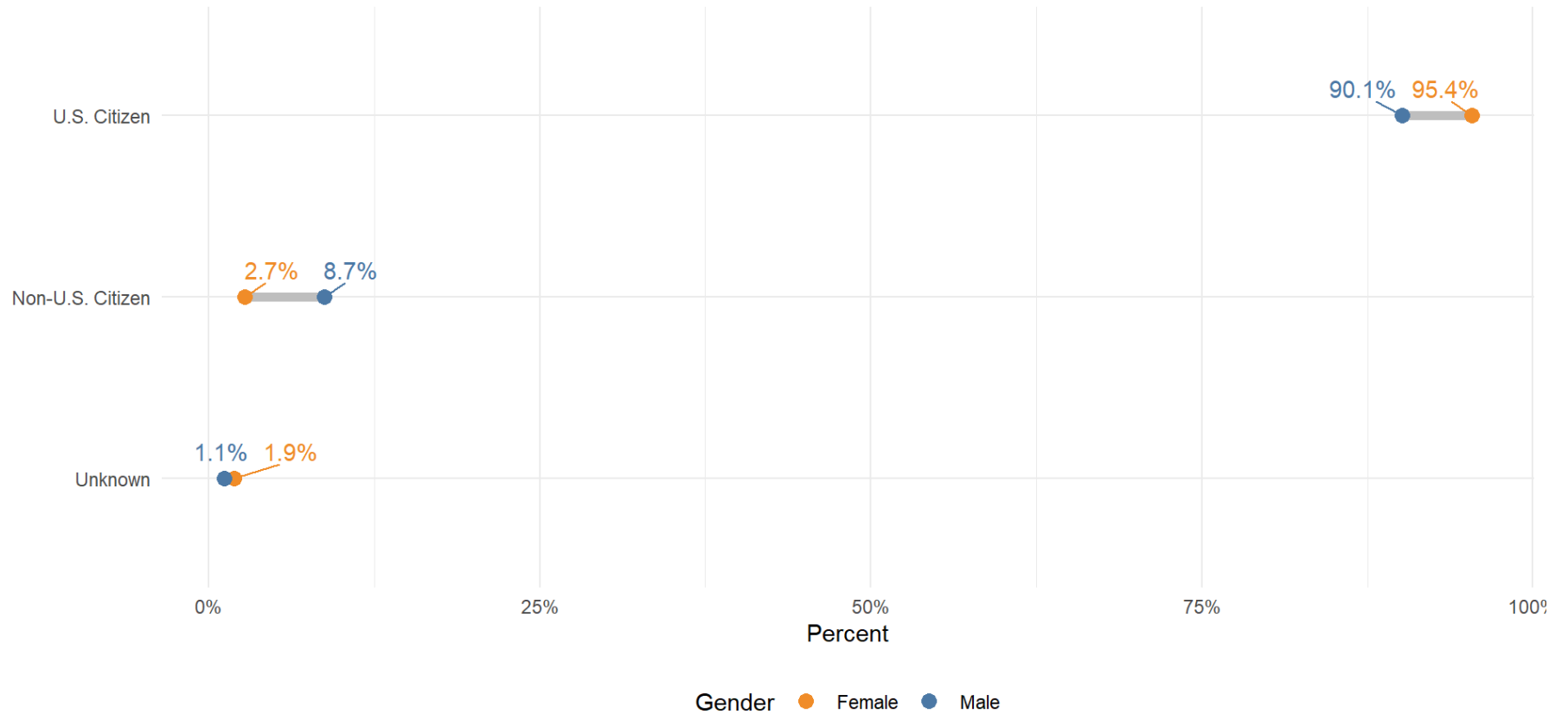

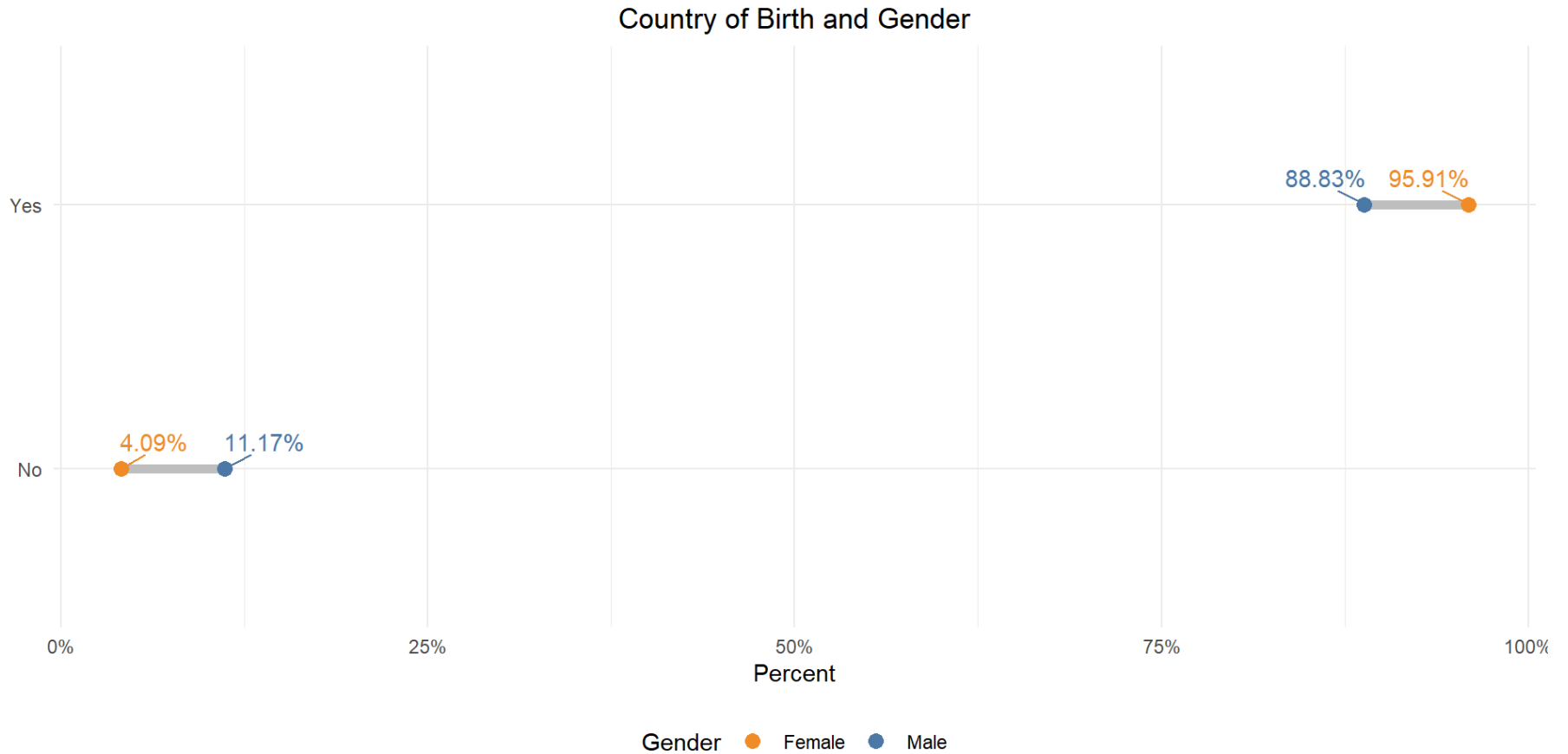

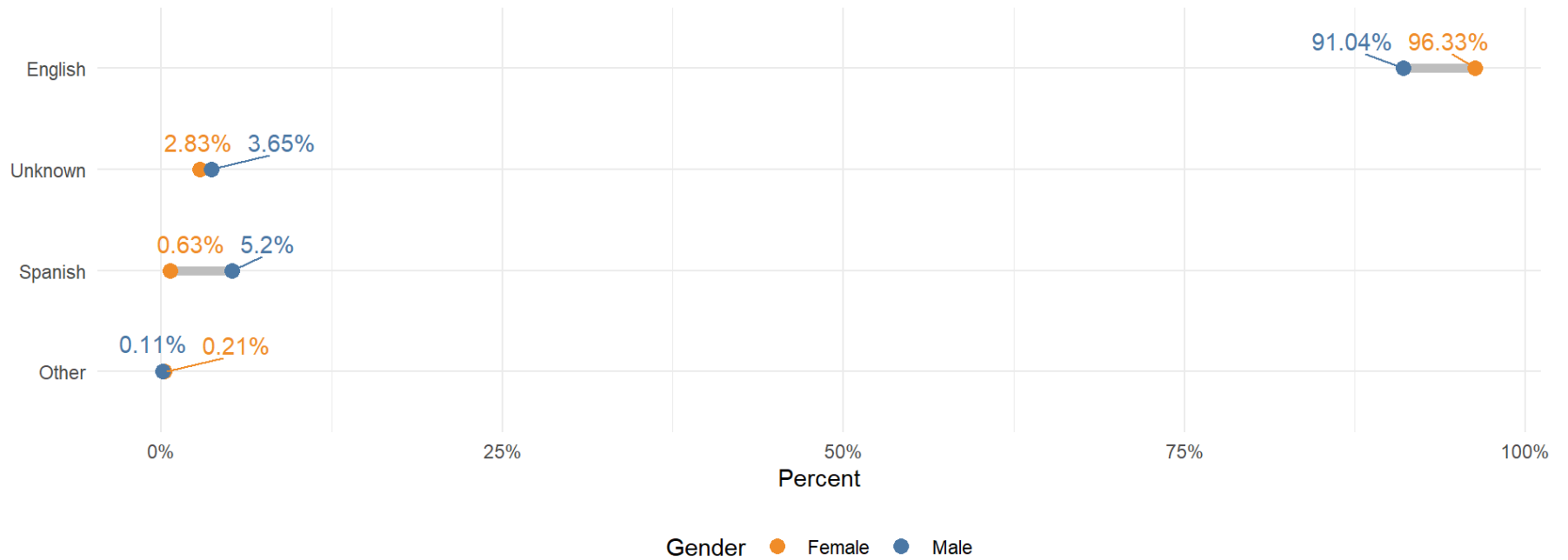

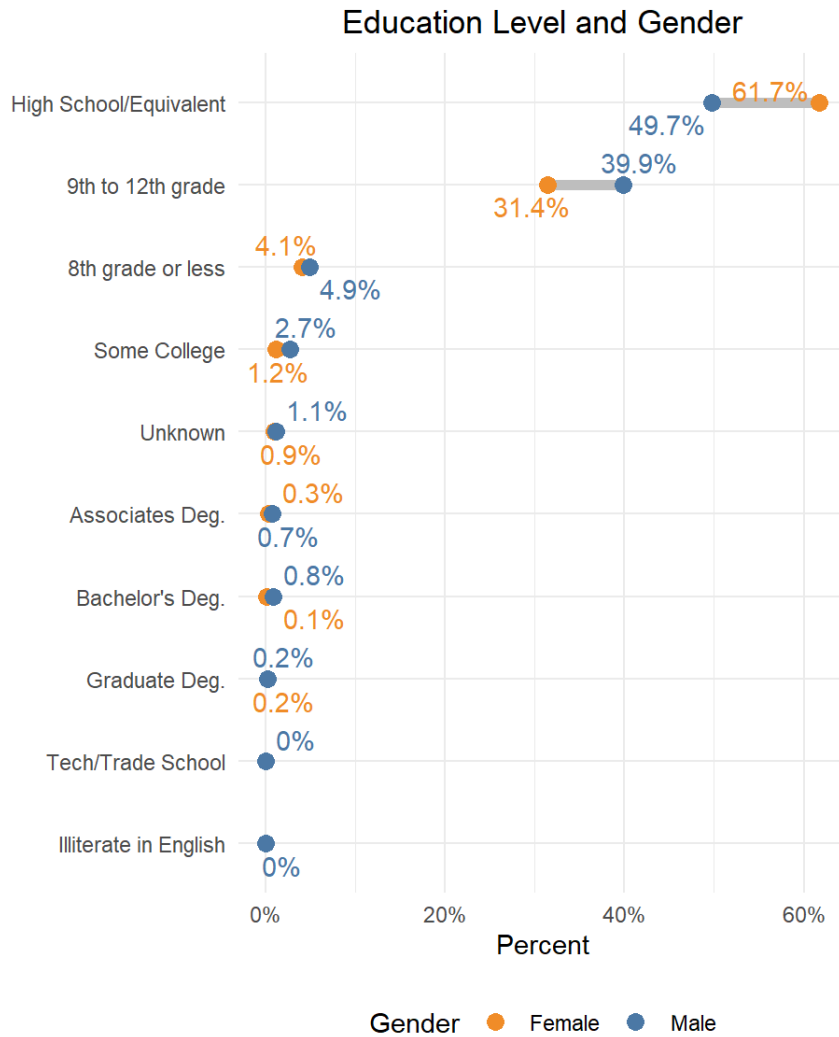

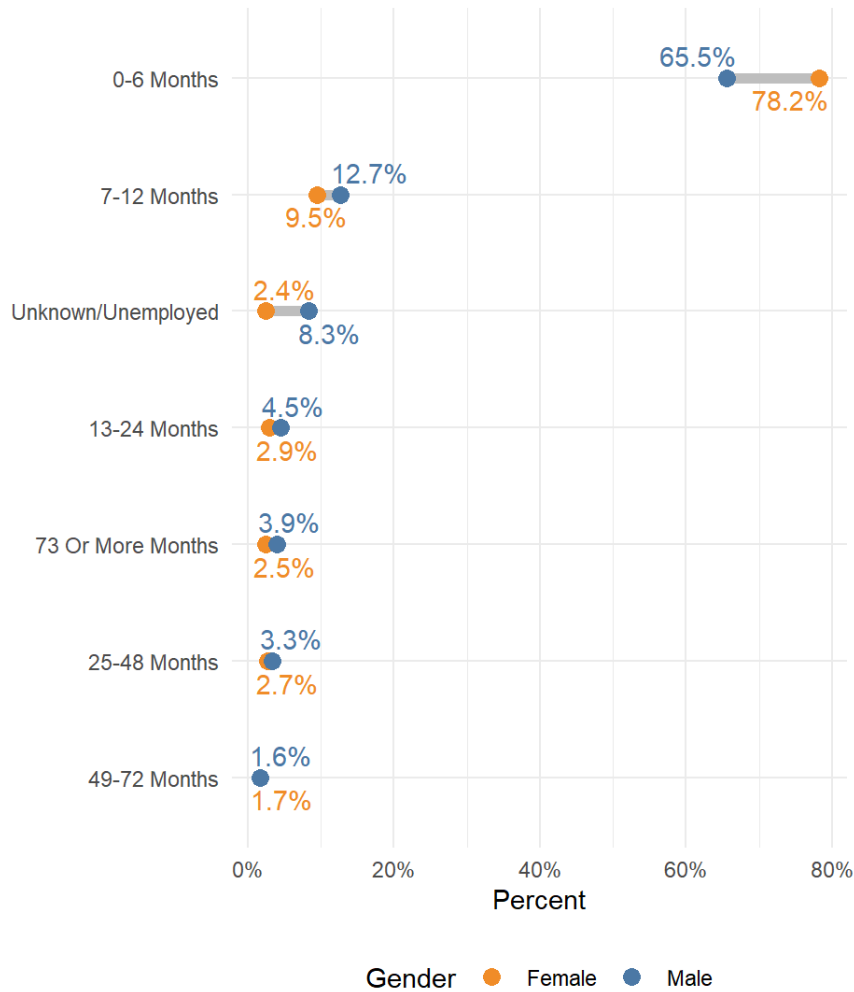

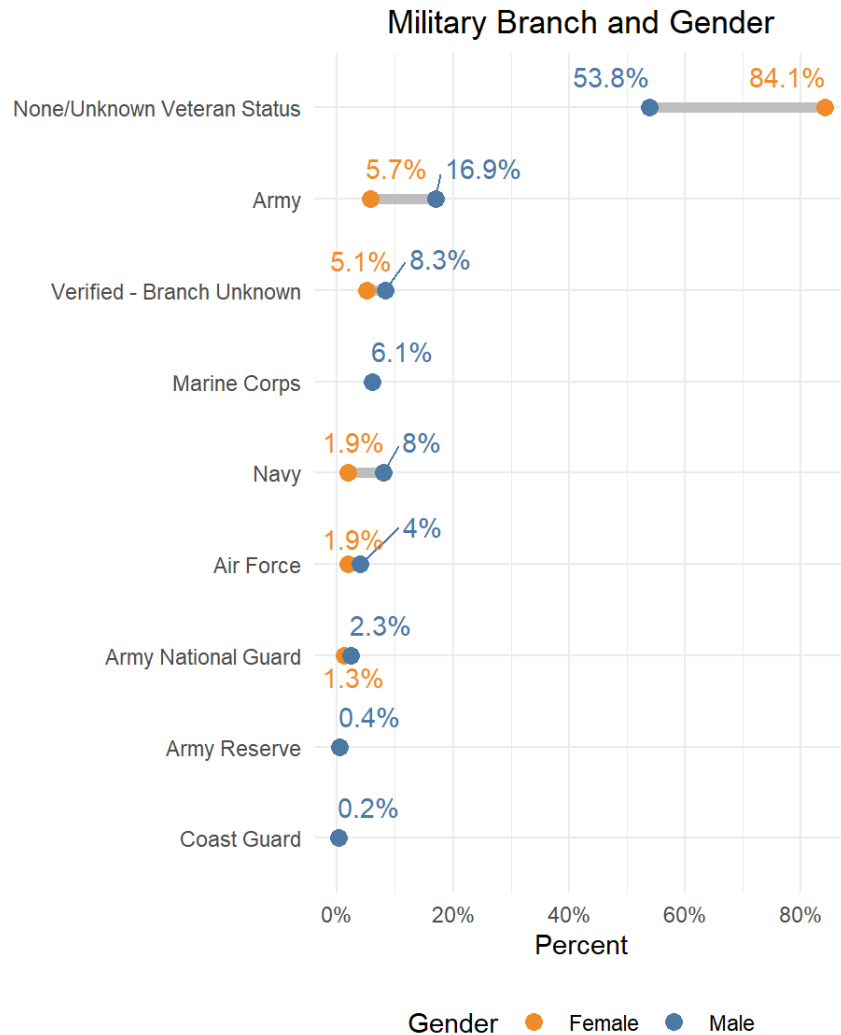

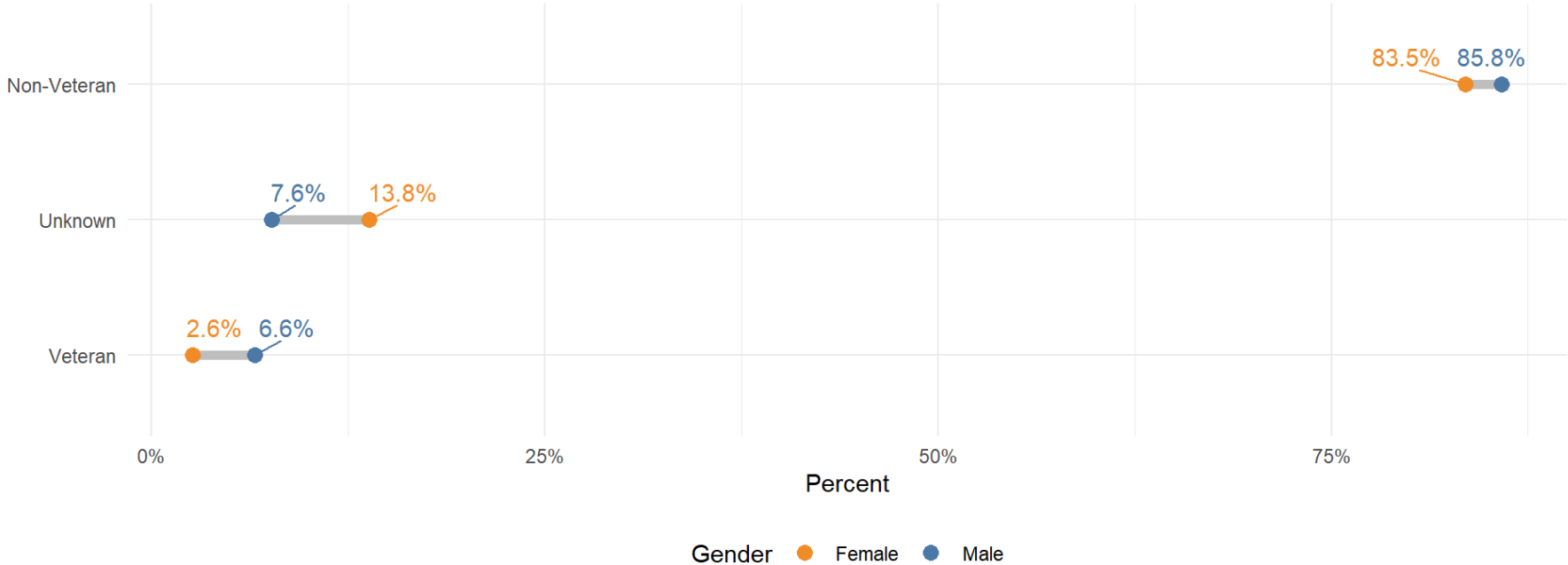

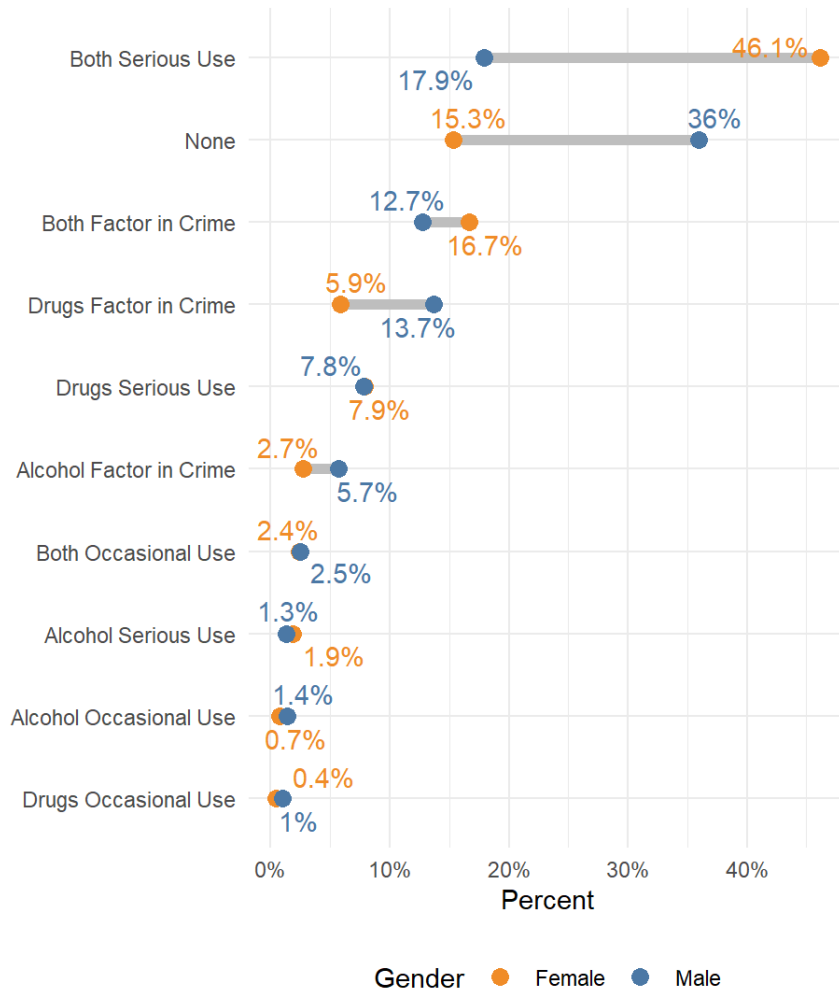

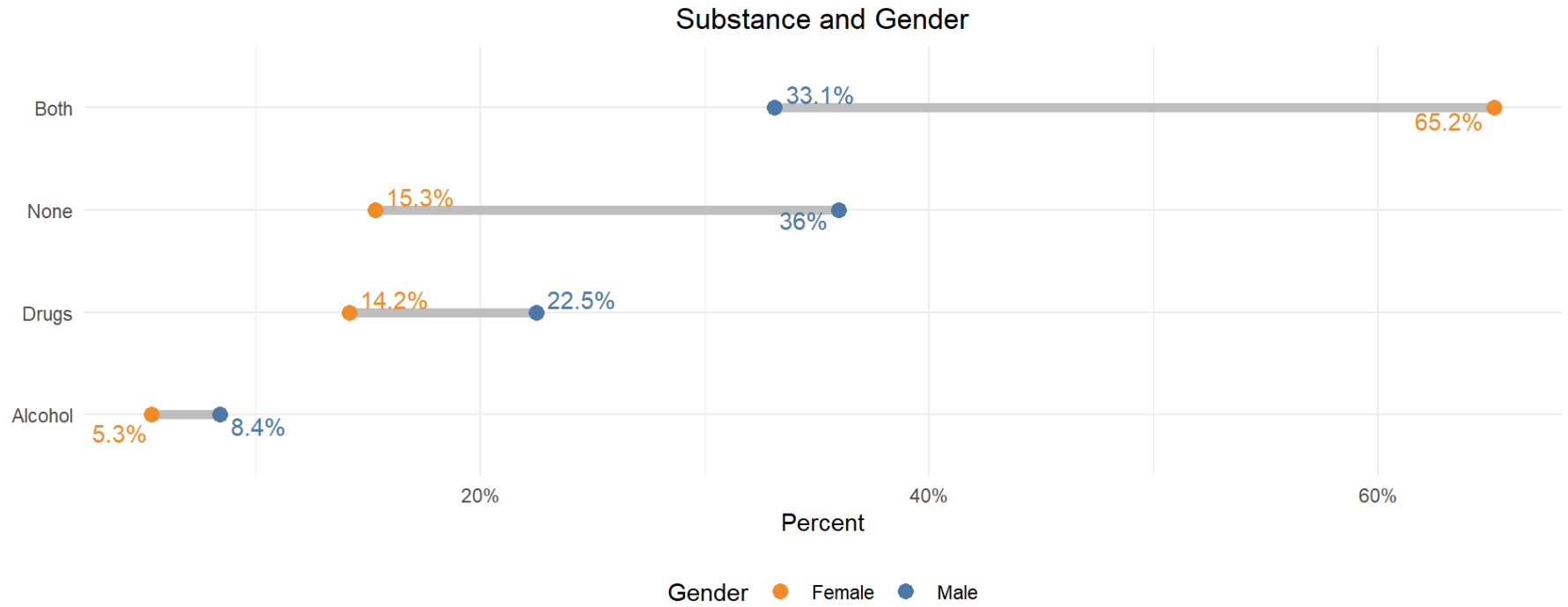

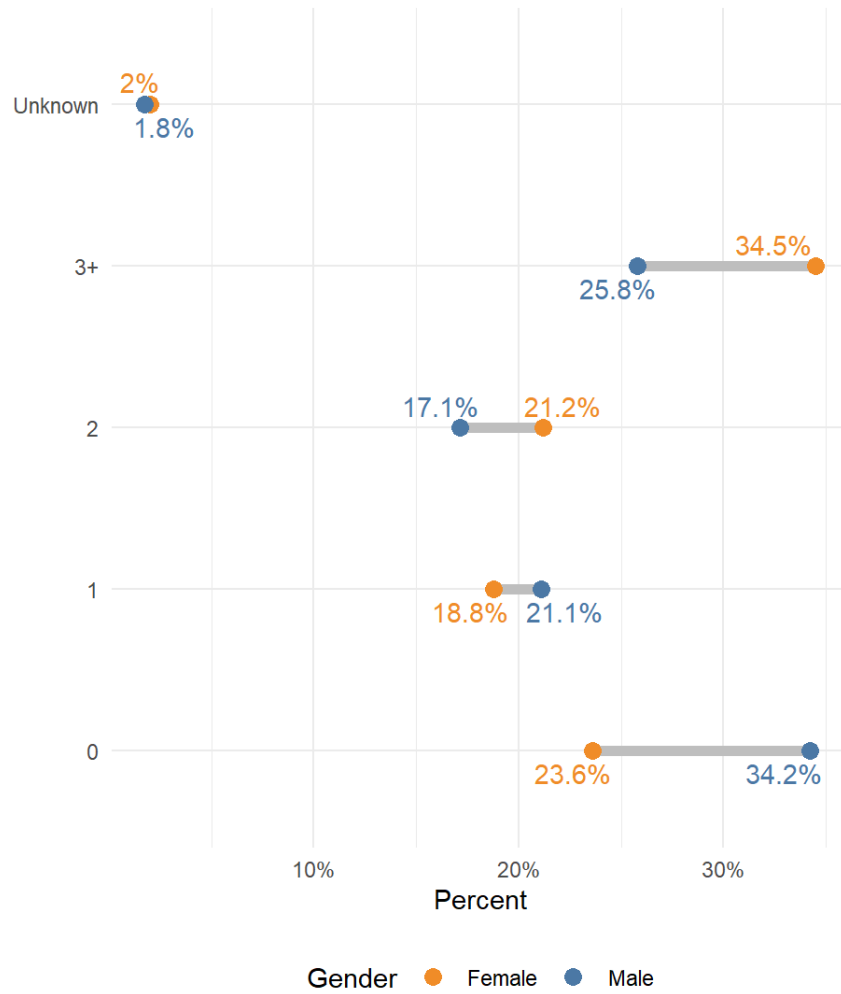

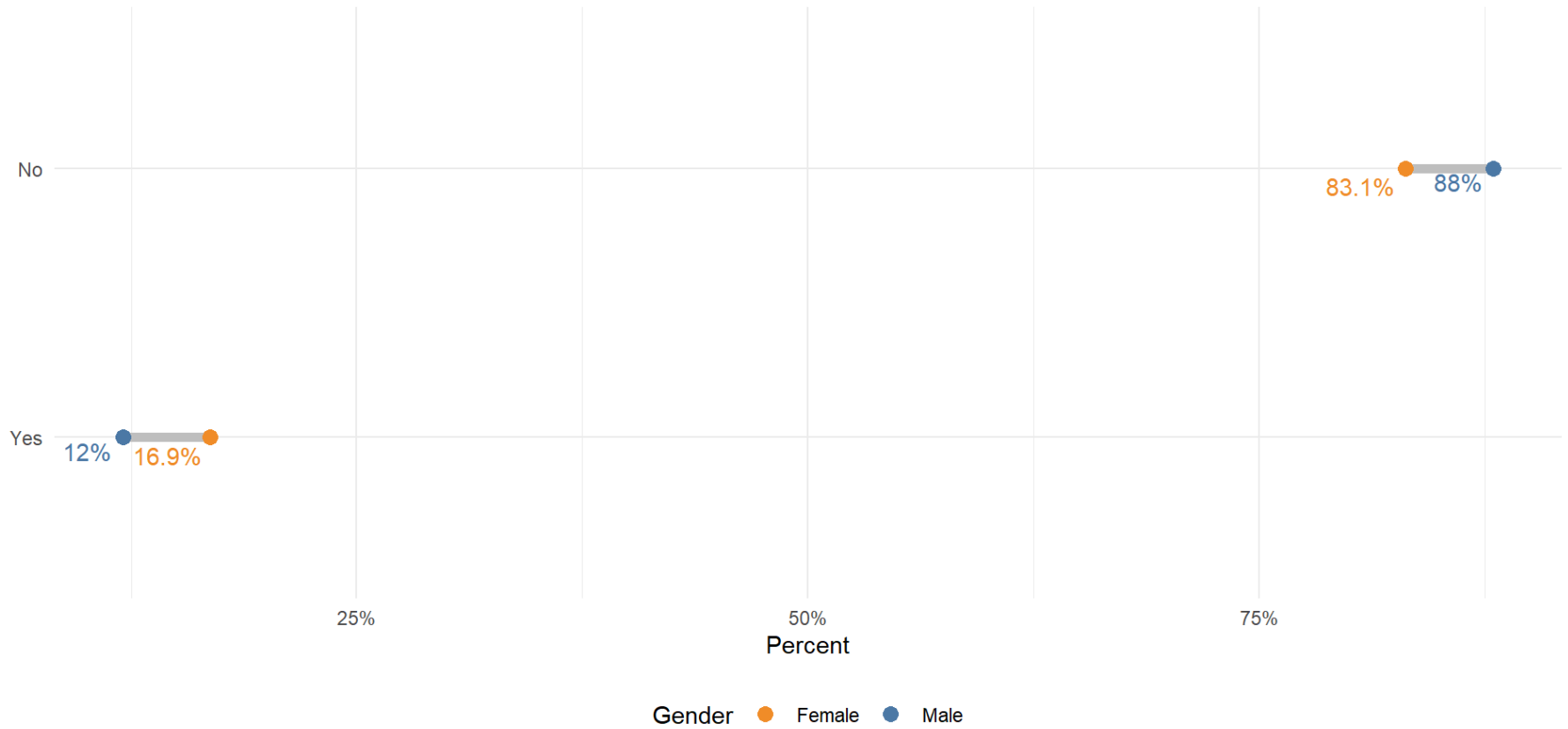

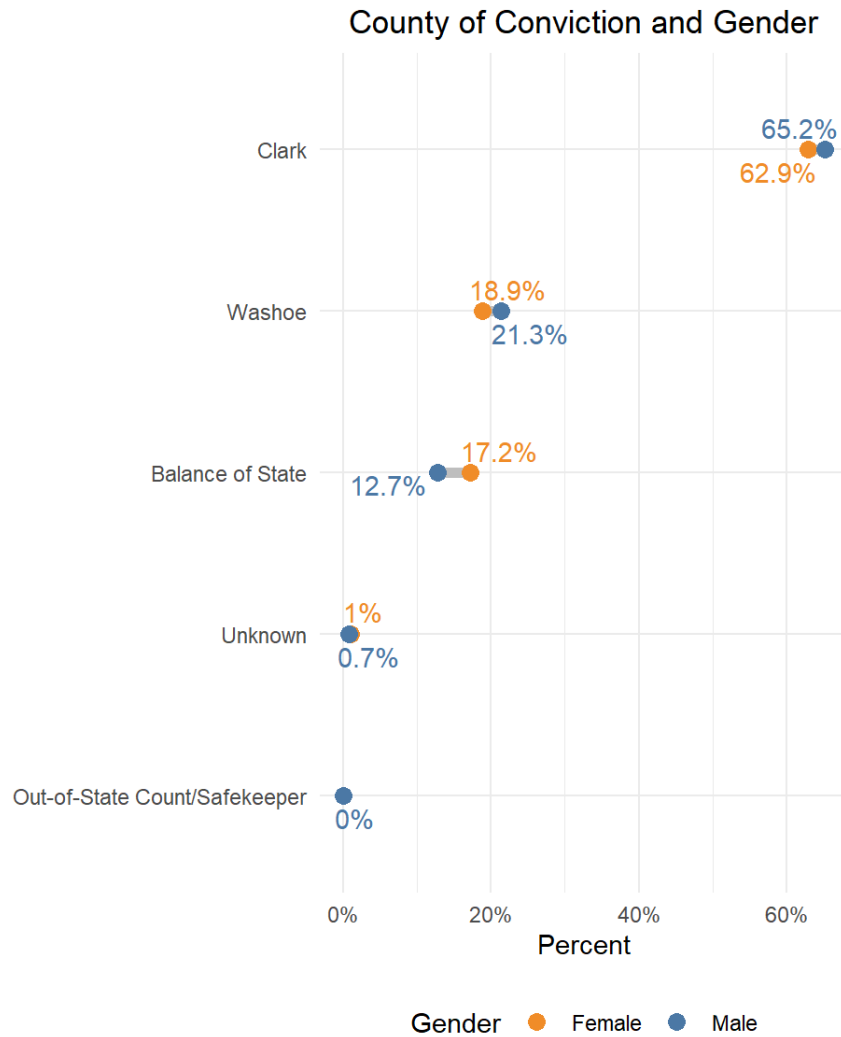

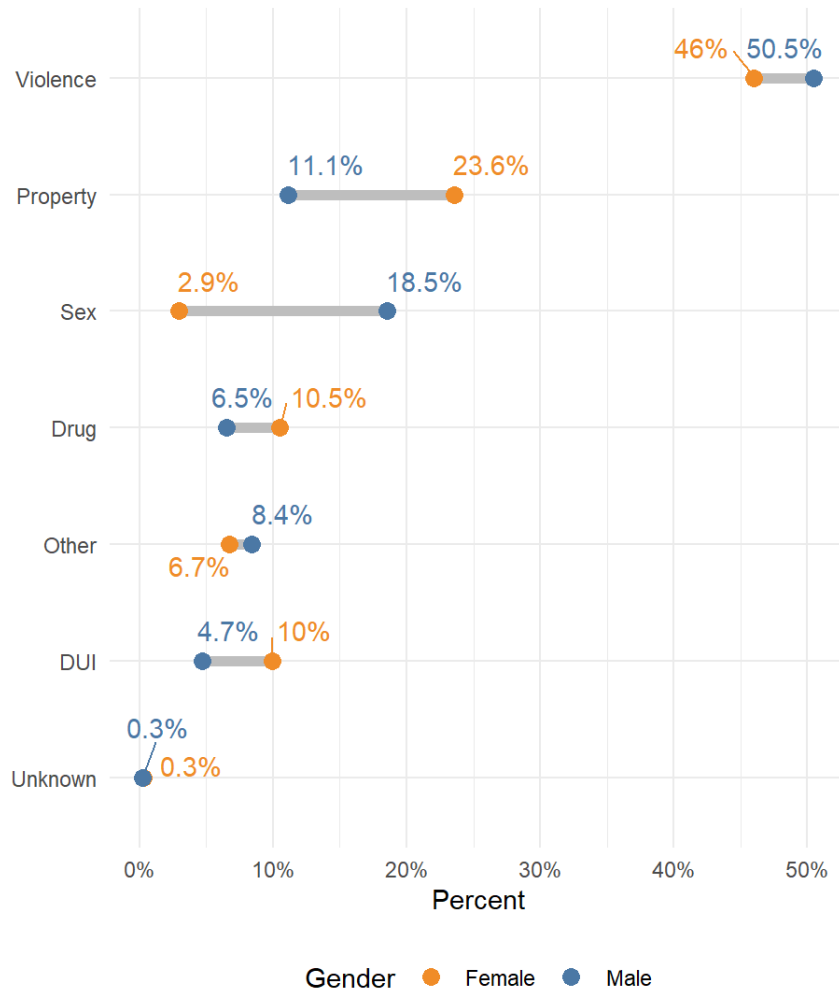

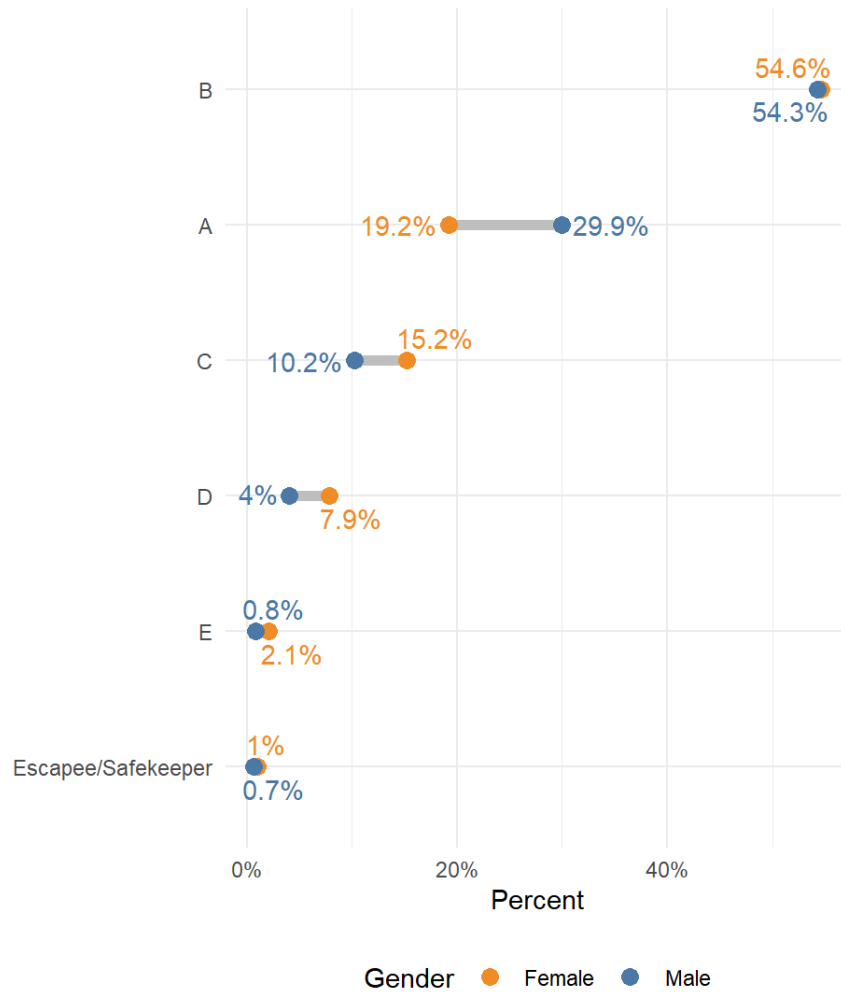

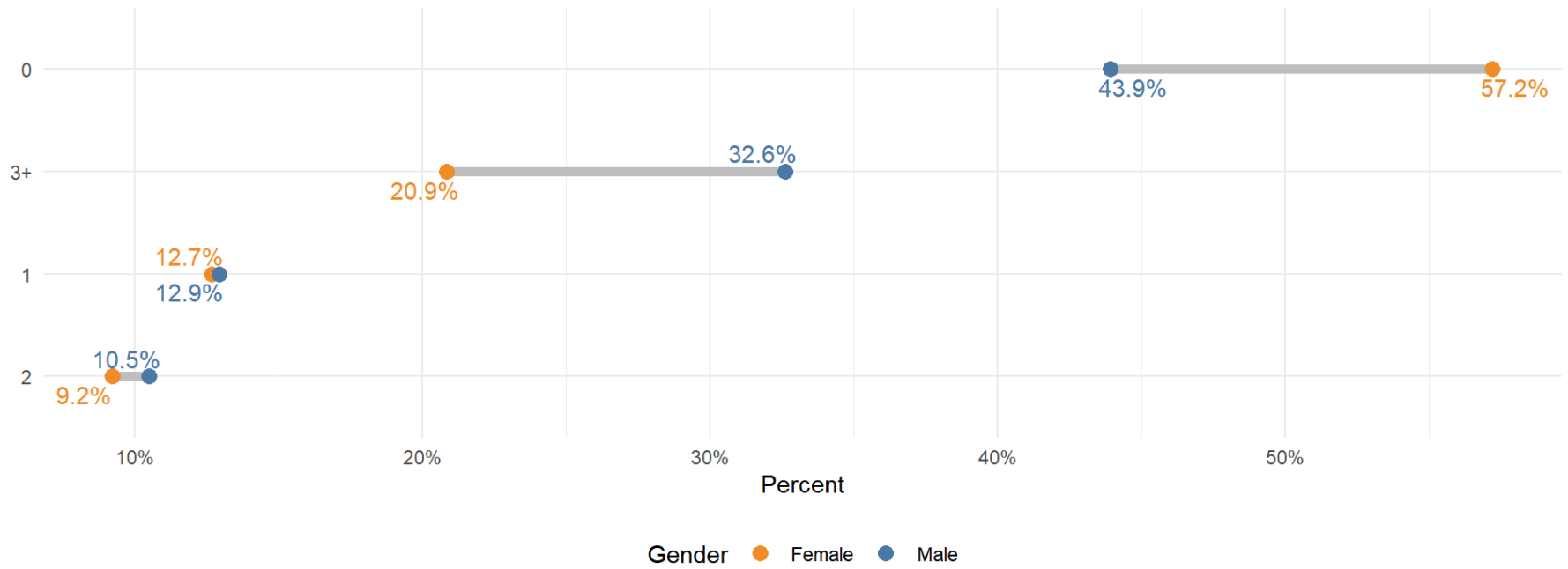

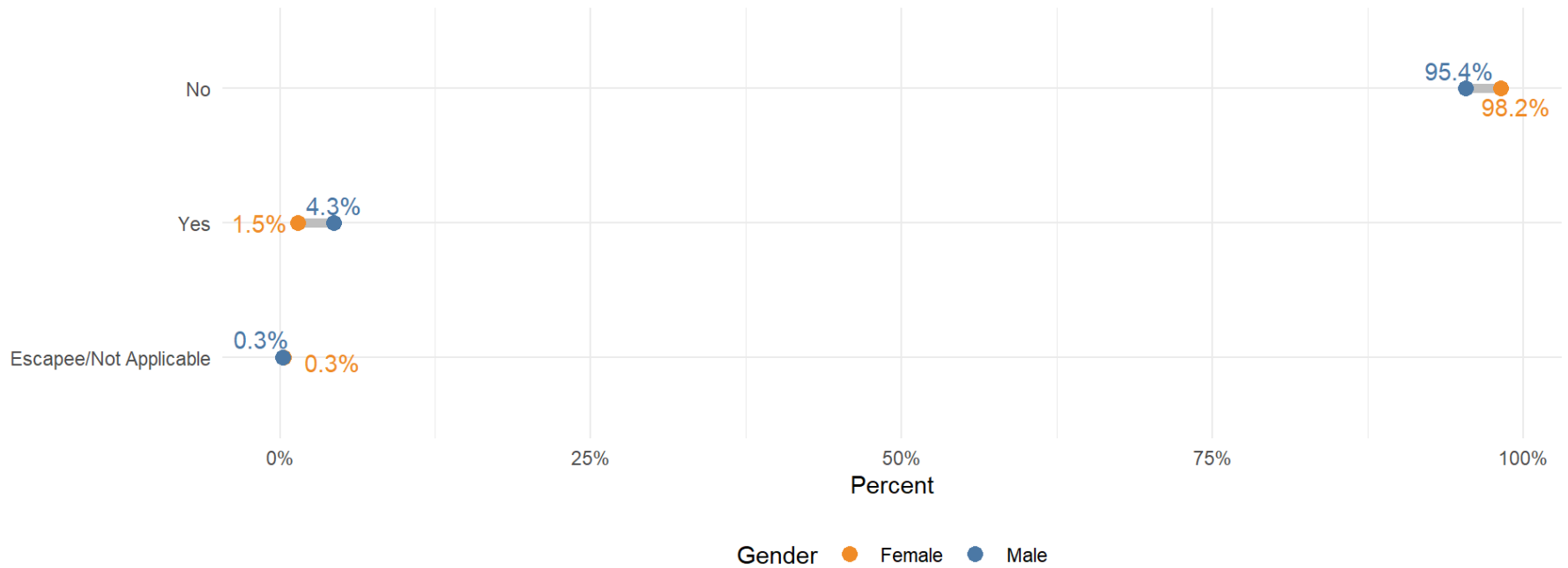

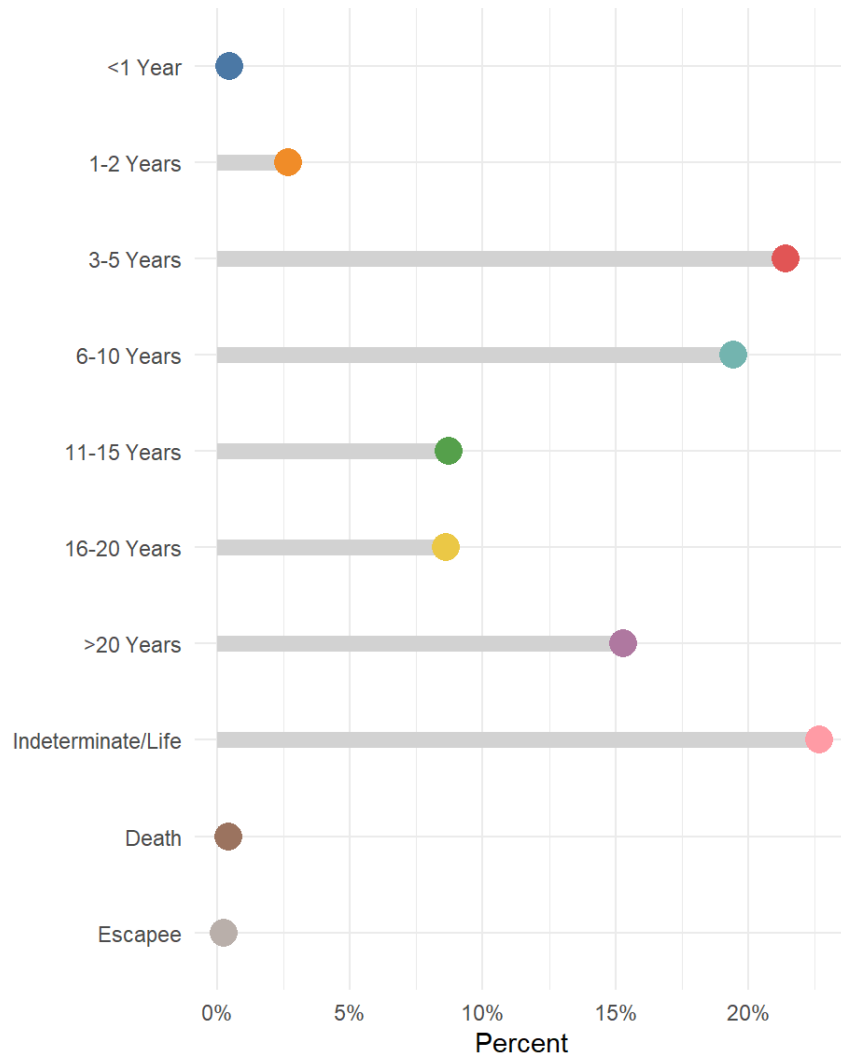

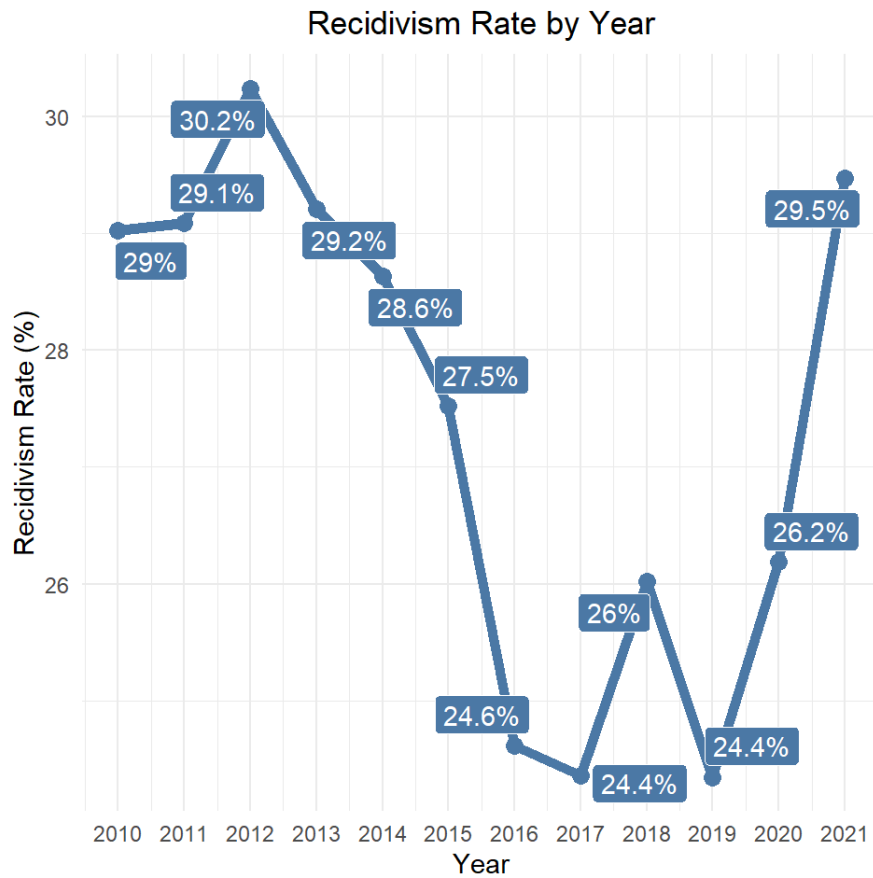

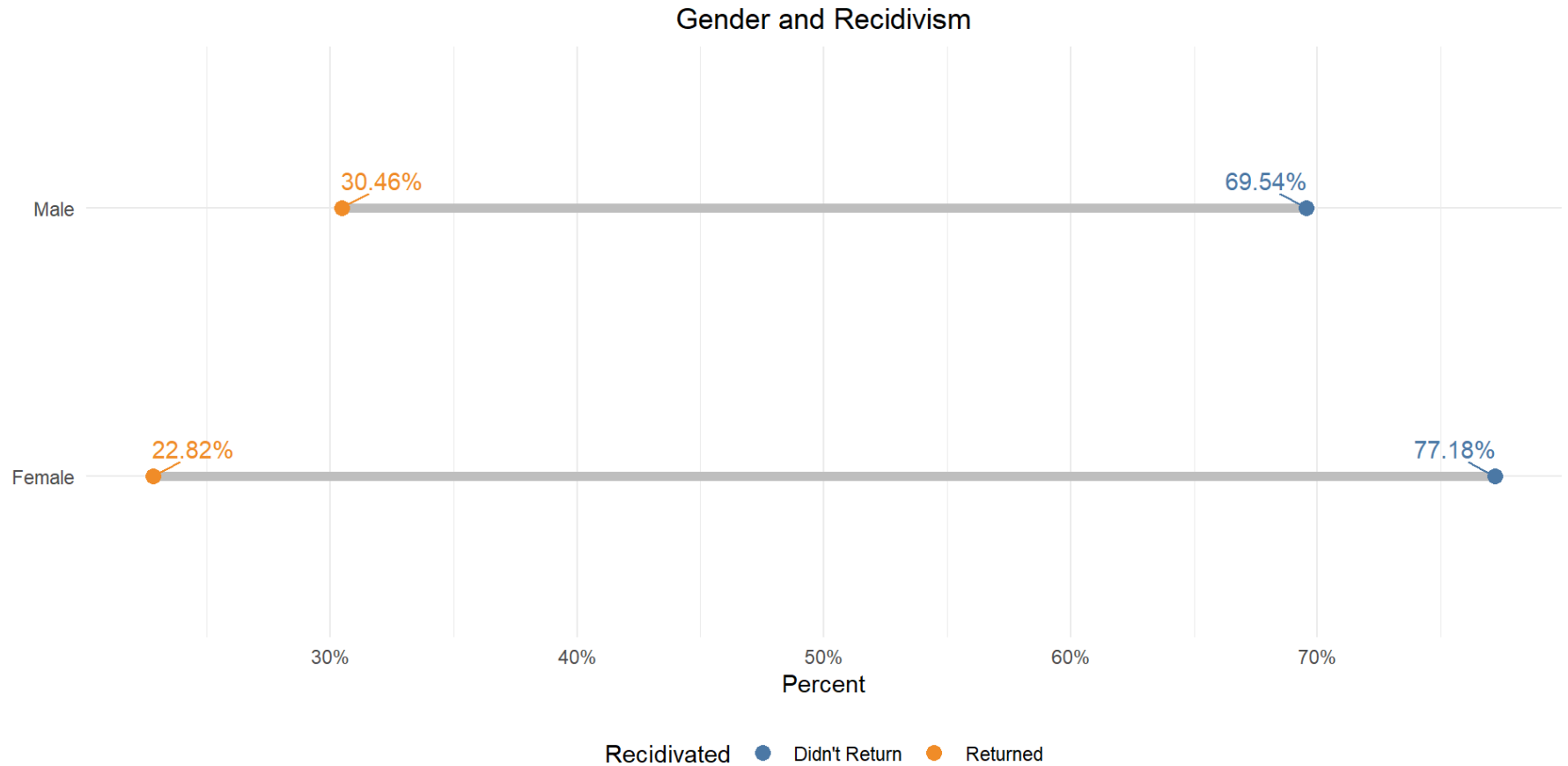

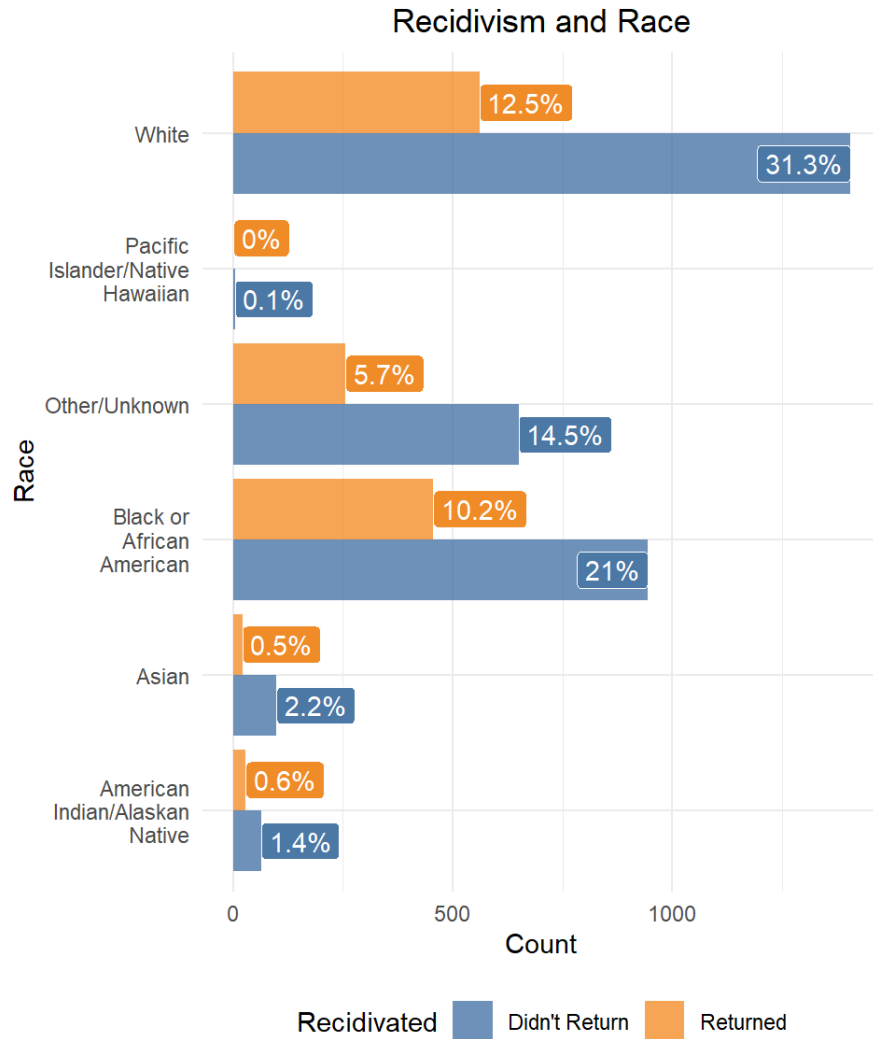

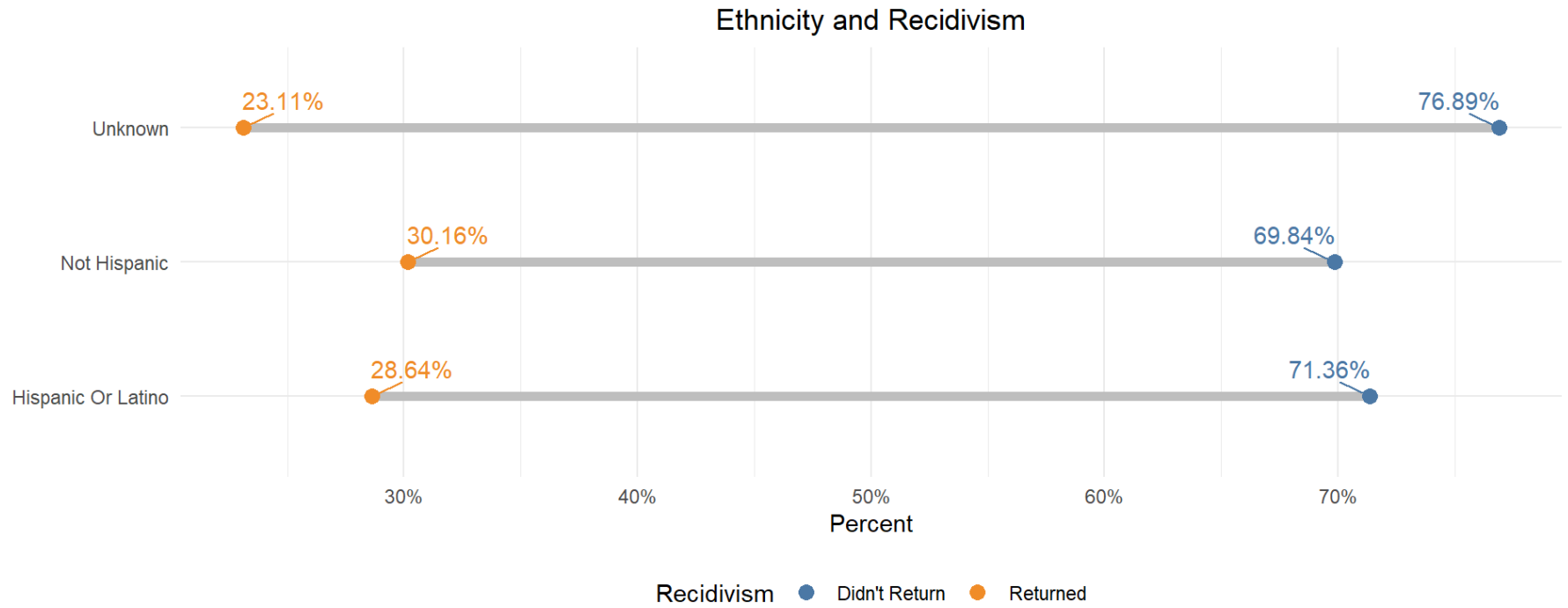

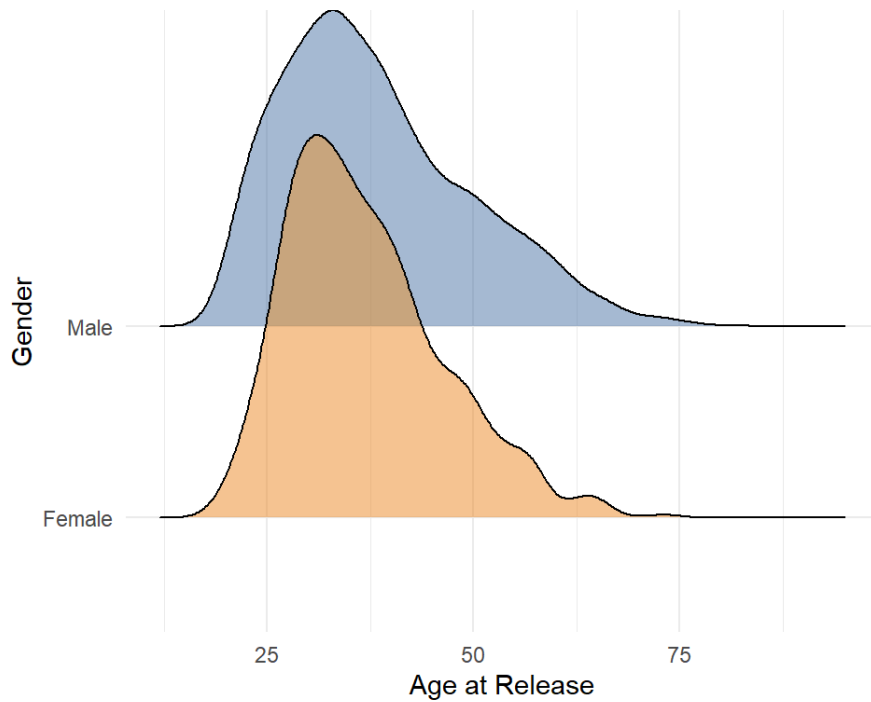

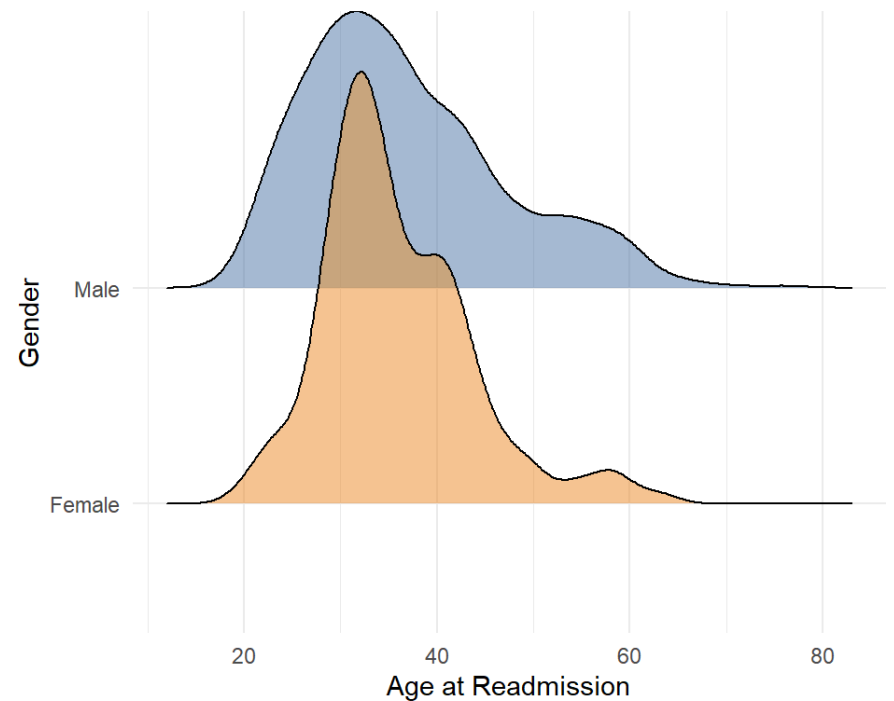

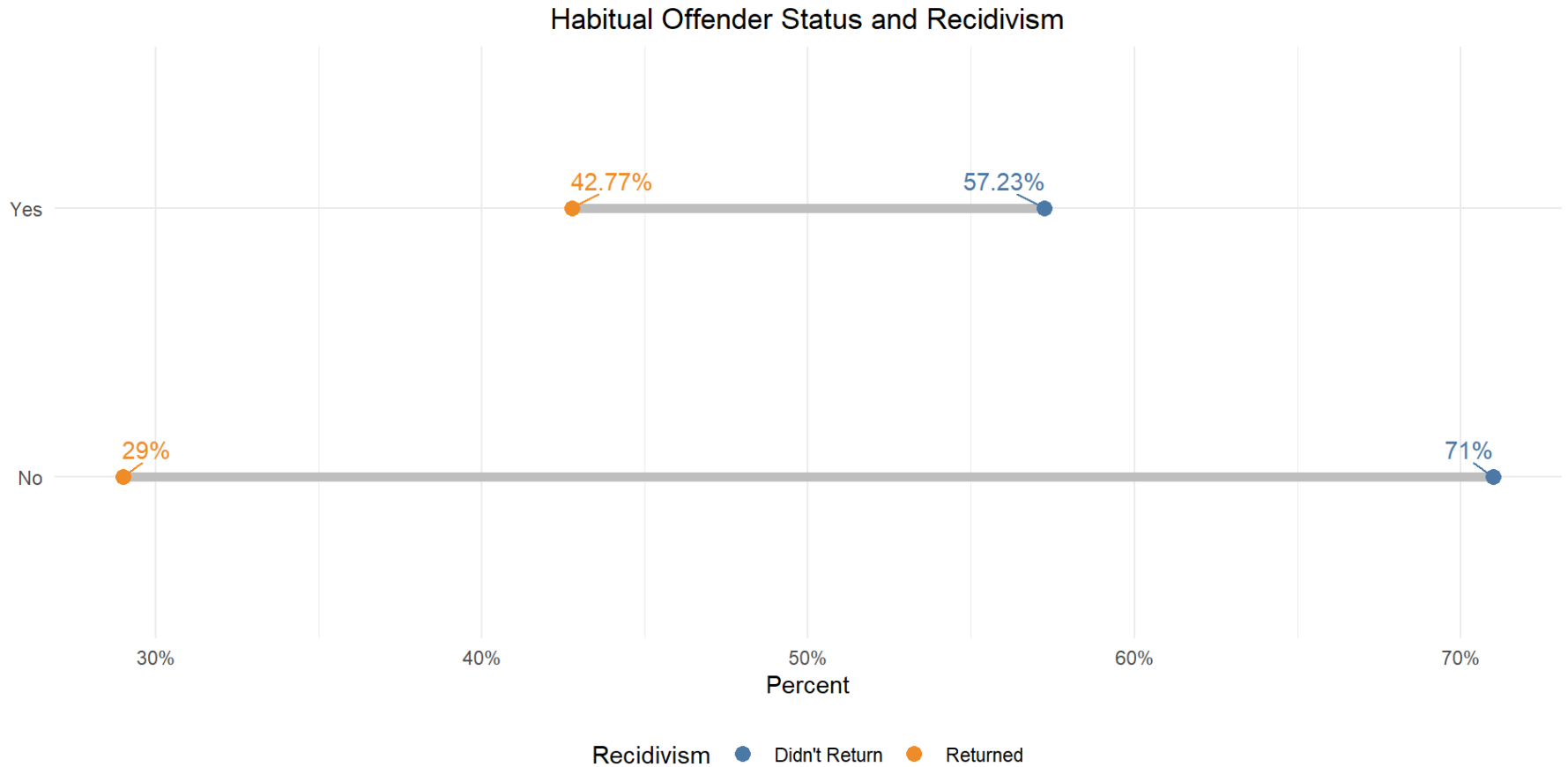

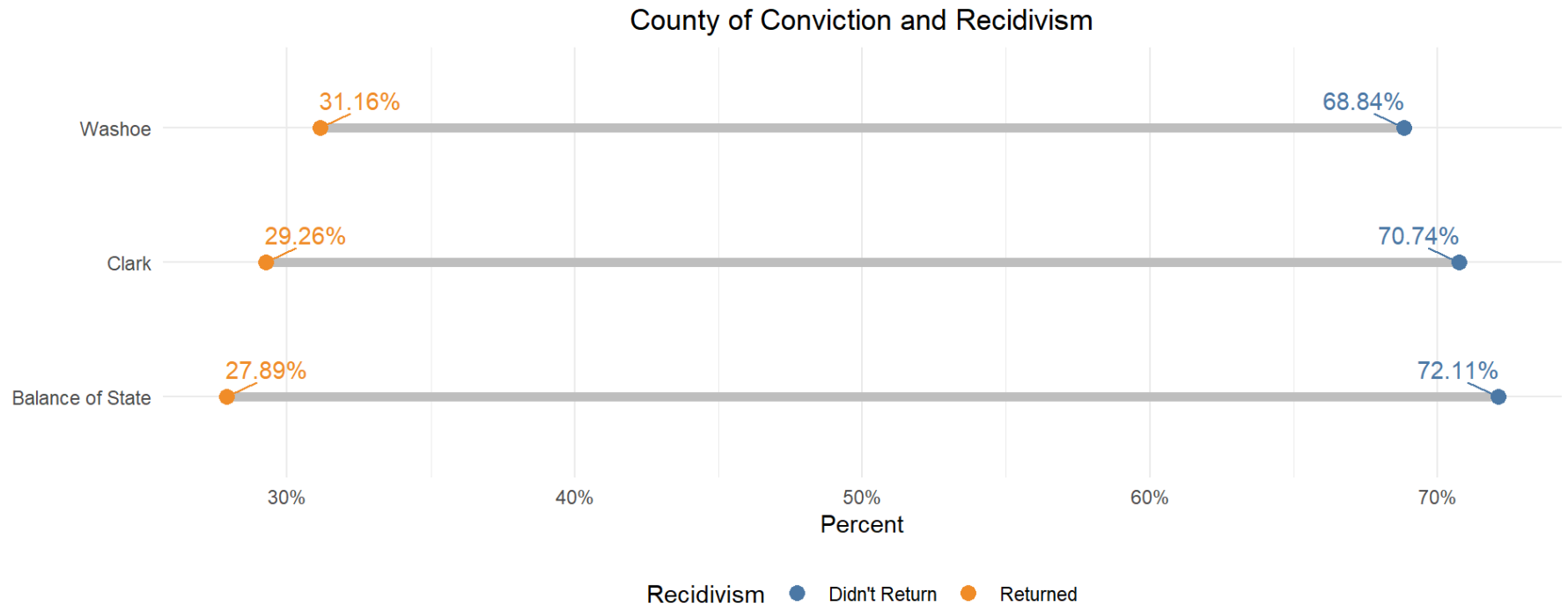

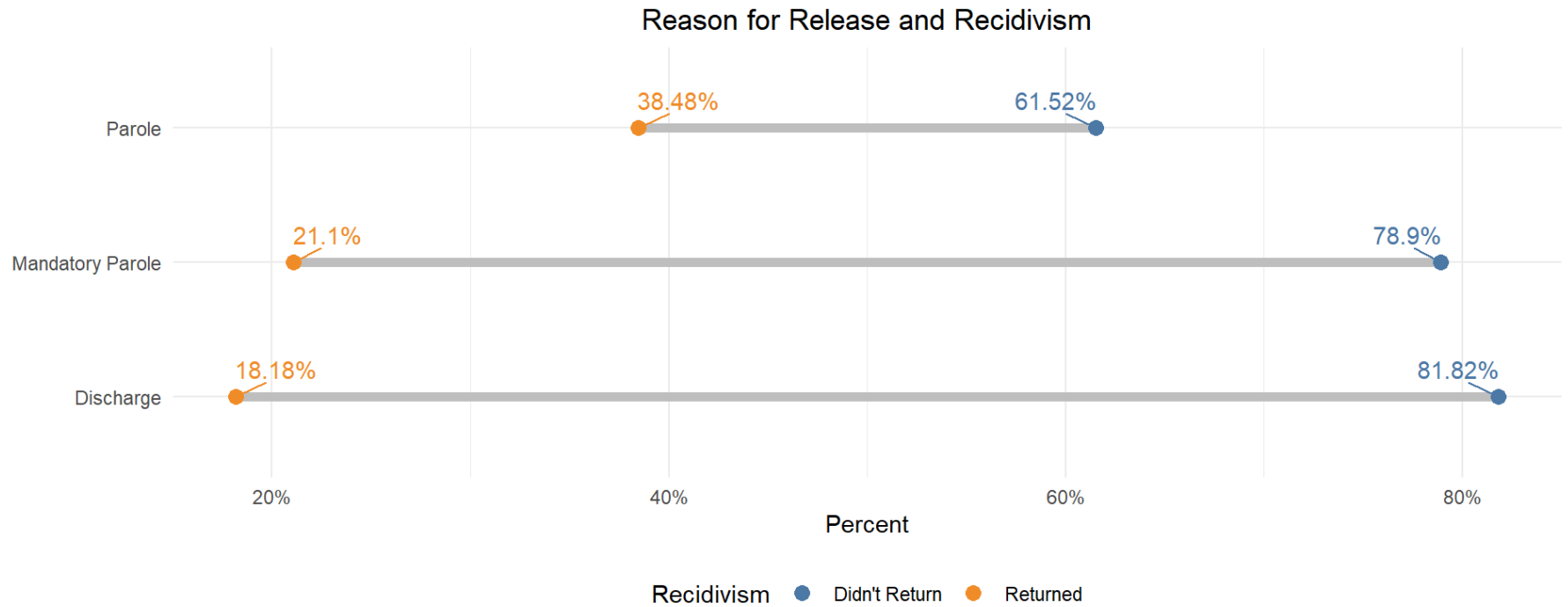

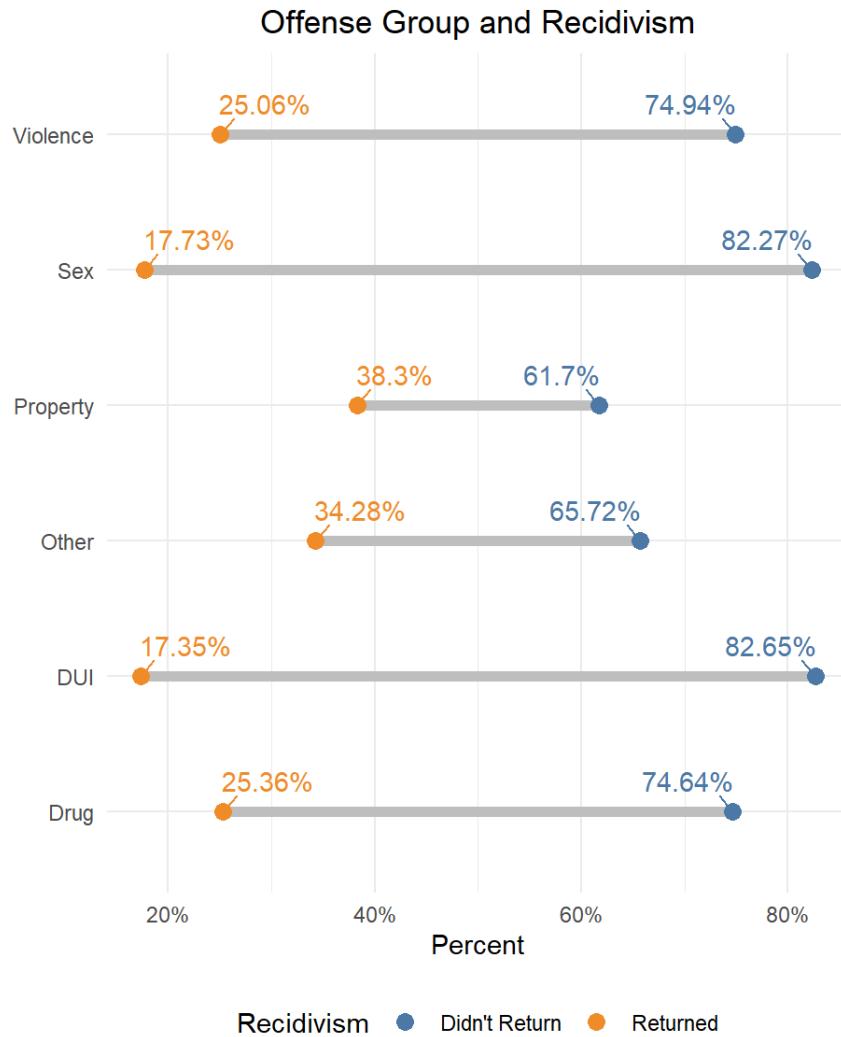

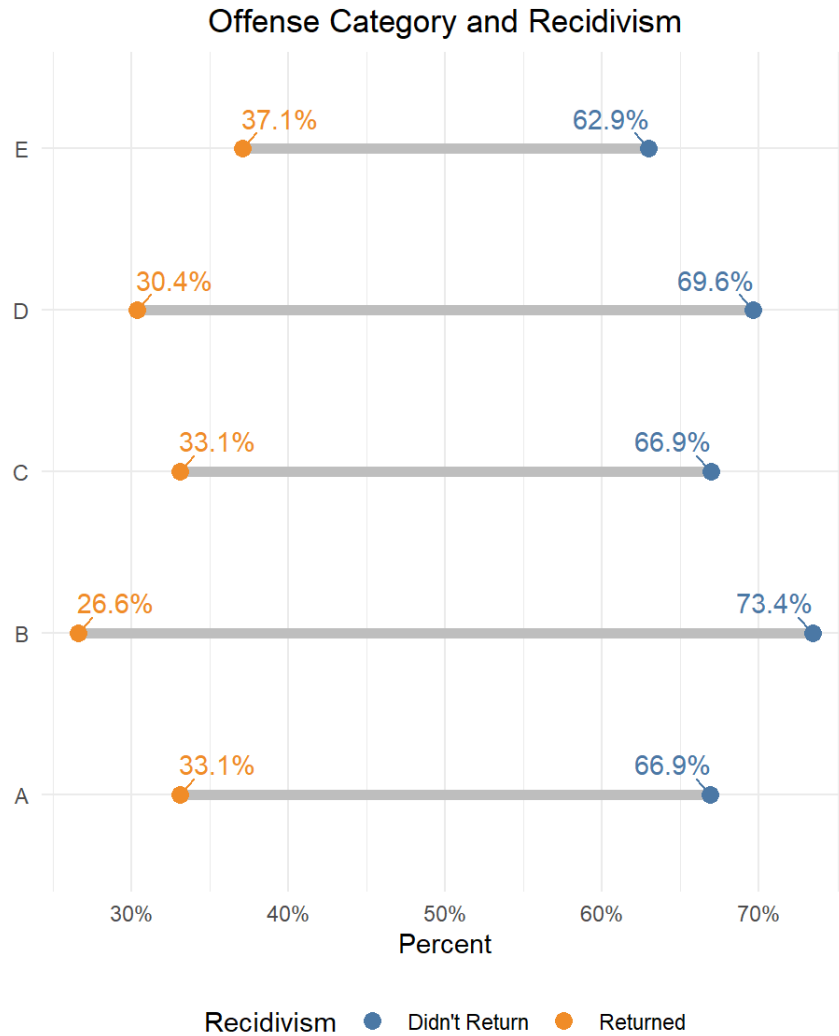

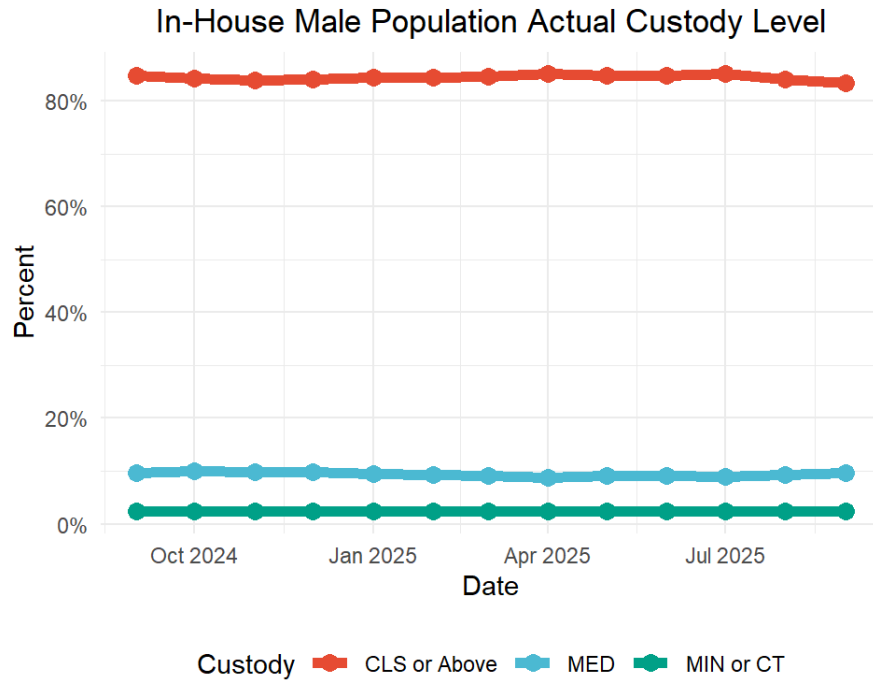

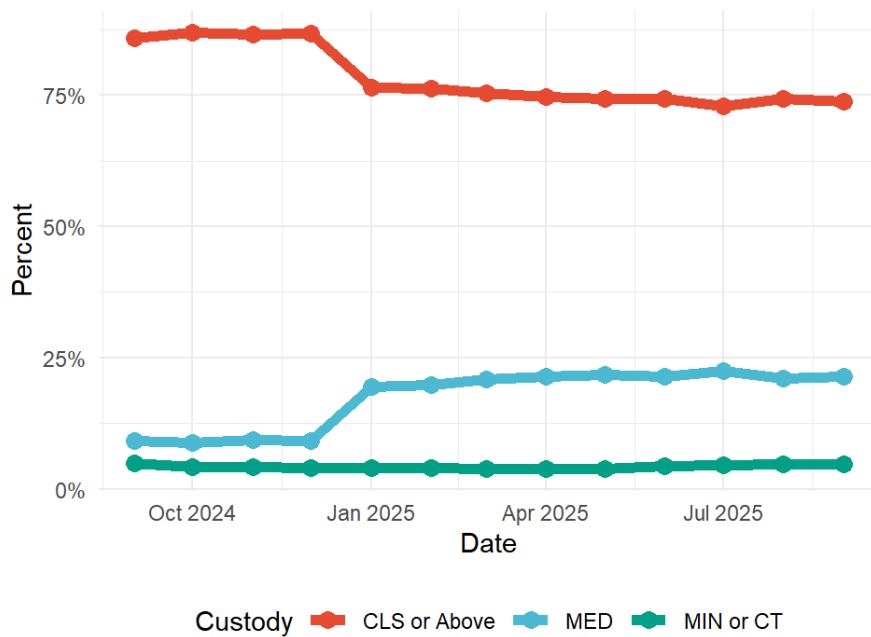

Legislatively Approved Male Total Population Projections (Current Biennium)

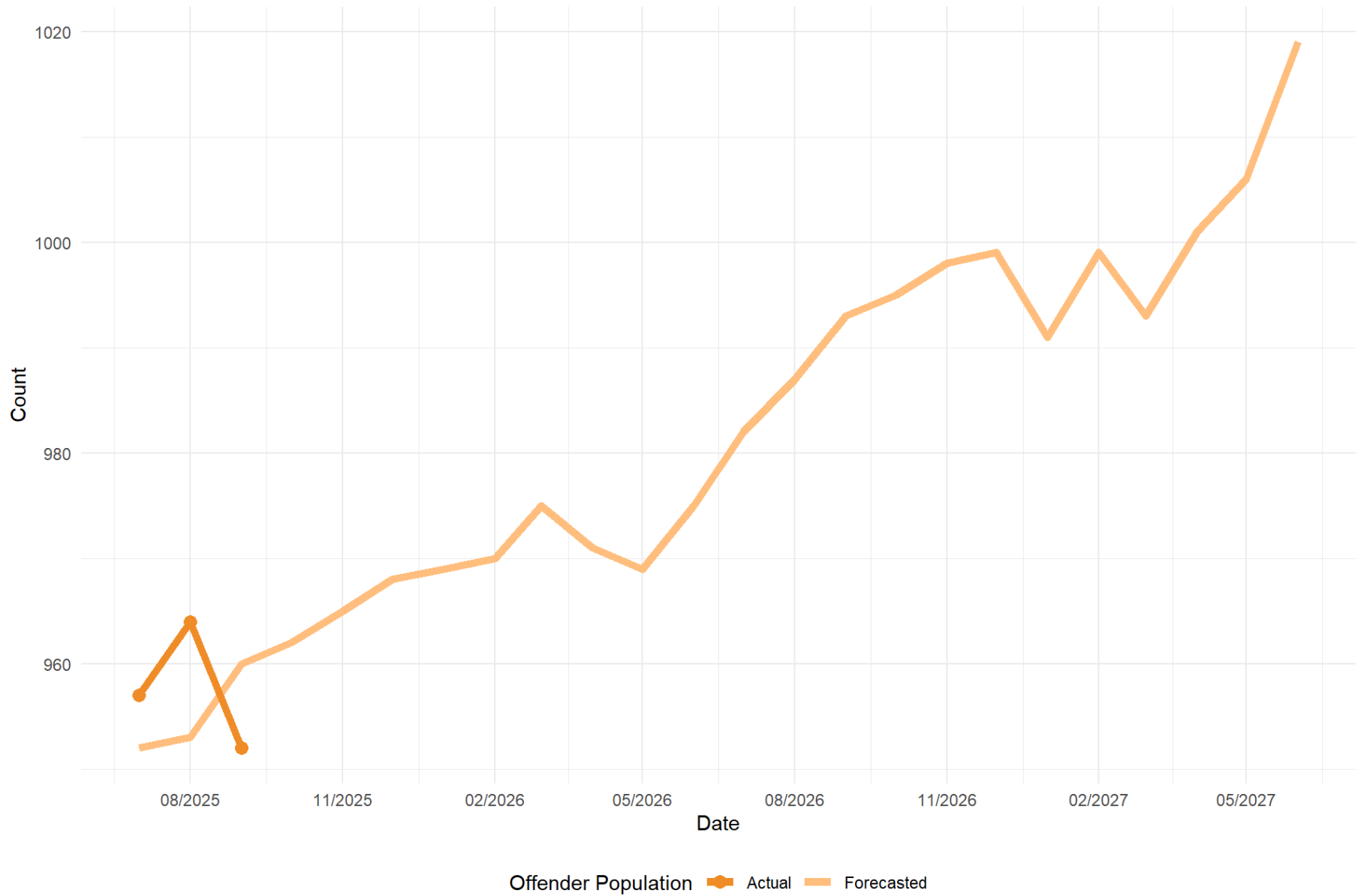

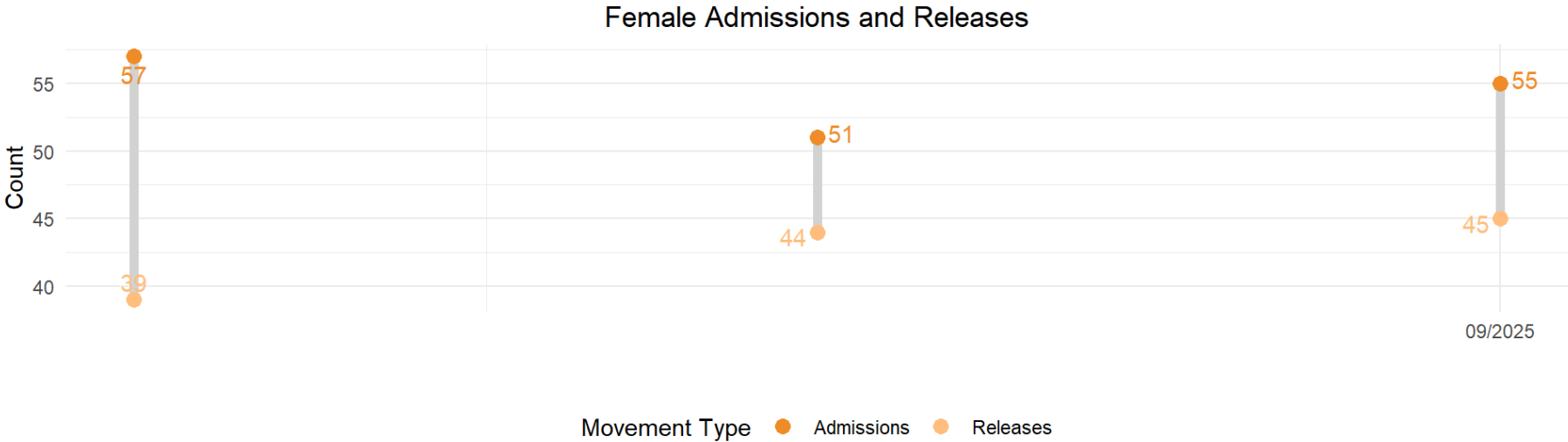
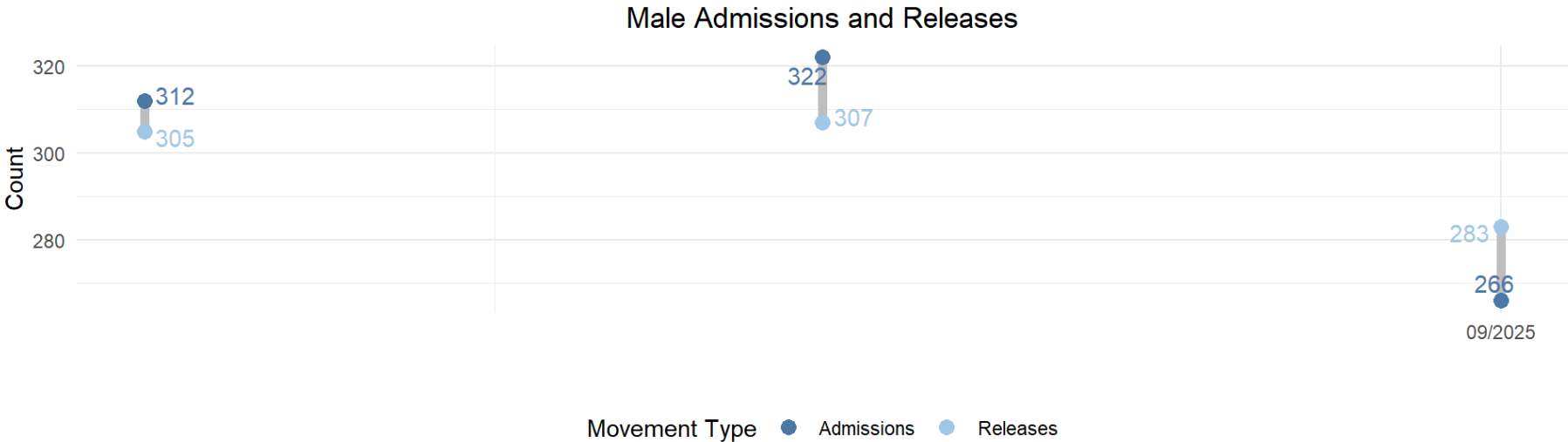

Legislatively Approved Female Total Population Projections (Current Biennium)

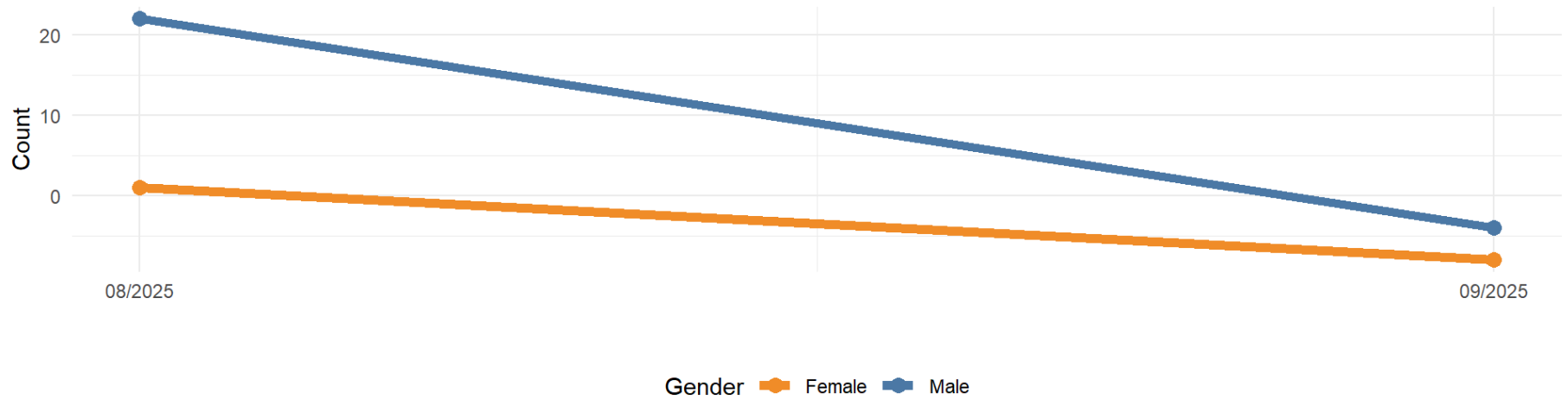

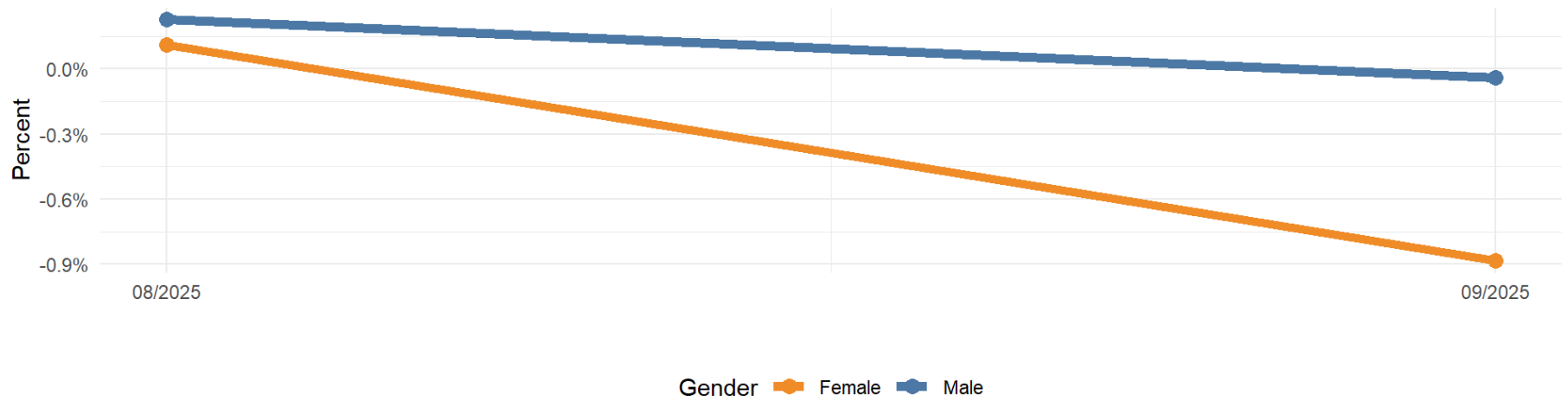

## Monthly In-House Population Change

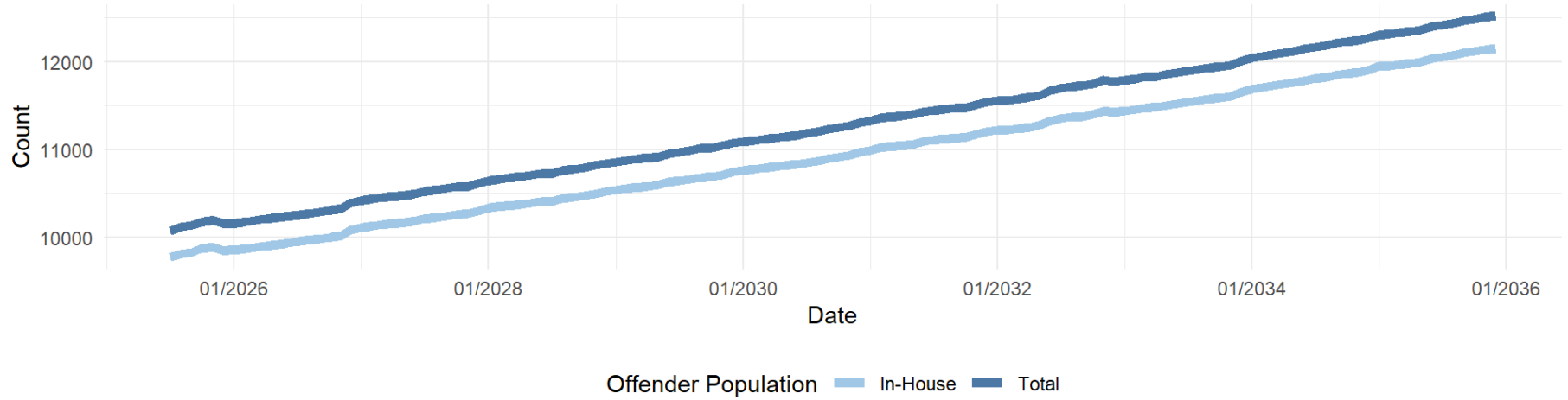


## Monthly In-House Population Percent Change

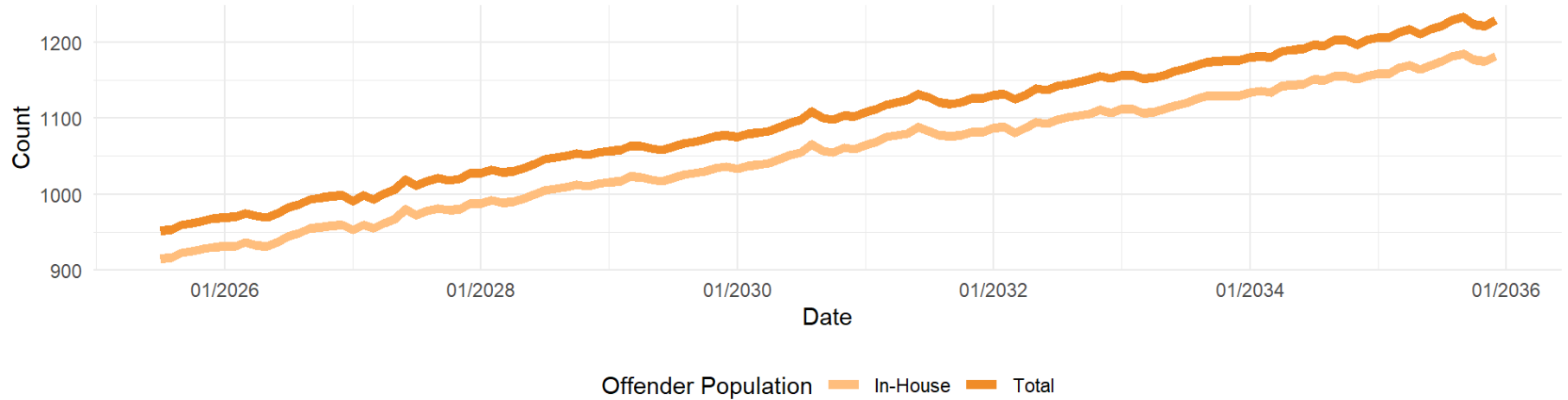

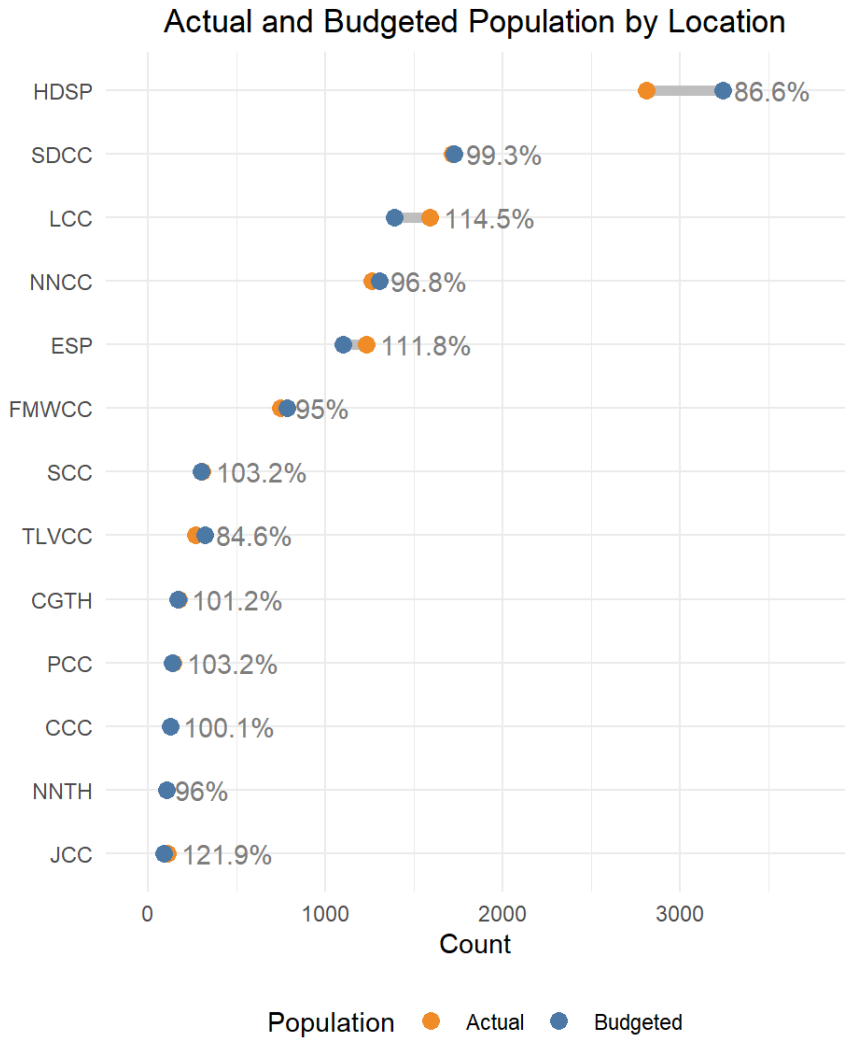

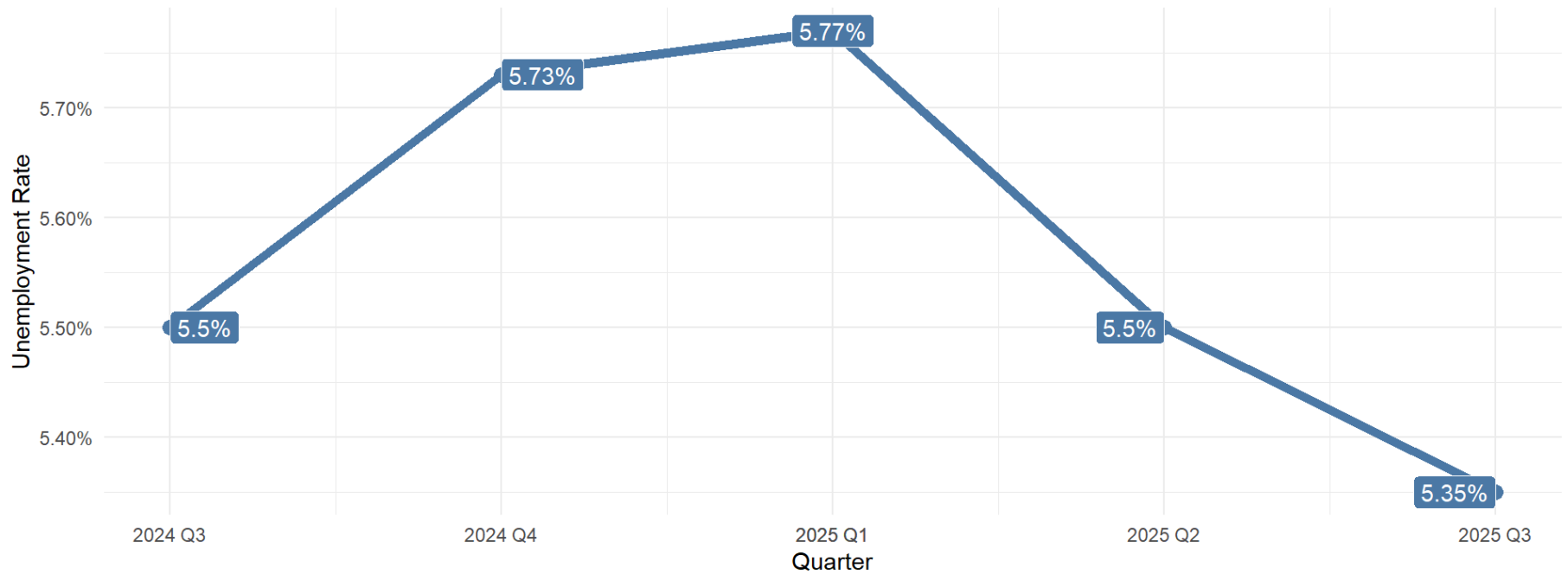

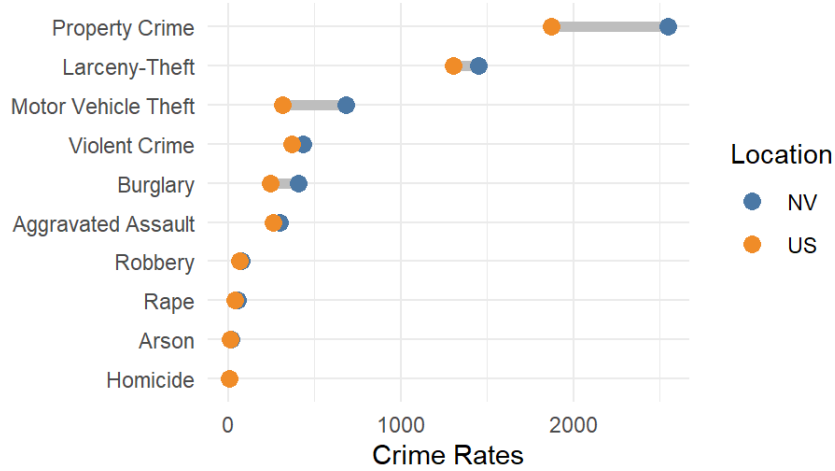

### Unemployment Rate in Nevada by Quarter

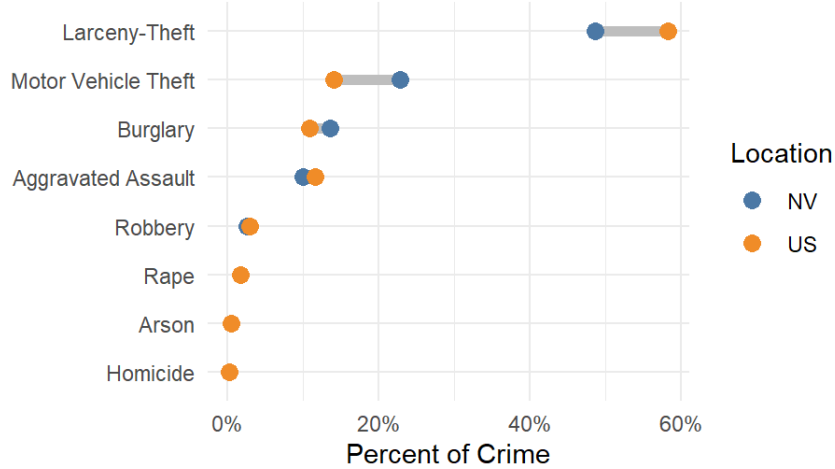
